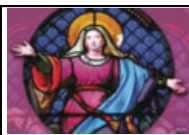

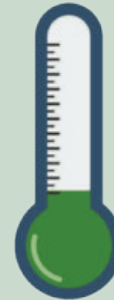

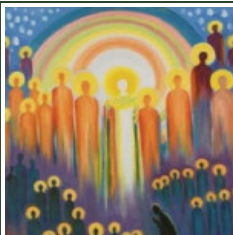
**Parish Feast Day**
