

During our hospitality weekends, we have asked all of you to reflect on your personal growth in three of the four "holy habits"

emphasized in our diocesan Go Make Disciples evangelization initiative: Daily Prayer, Sunday Mass, Monthly Confession. Next weekend we ask you to share possibilities of continuing or beginning the habit of Friday Sacrifice. This can take many forms and doesn't have to be specific to Friday (although the U.S, bishops recommend abstaining from meat on Fridays annually.) Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On December 8, 1854 Pope Pius IX pronounced and defined the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception. In this doctrine he stated our belief that Mary was "preserved exempt from all stain of original sin". This feast is often confused as celebrating Christ being conceived but is actually the celebration of Mary's conception free from sin.
