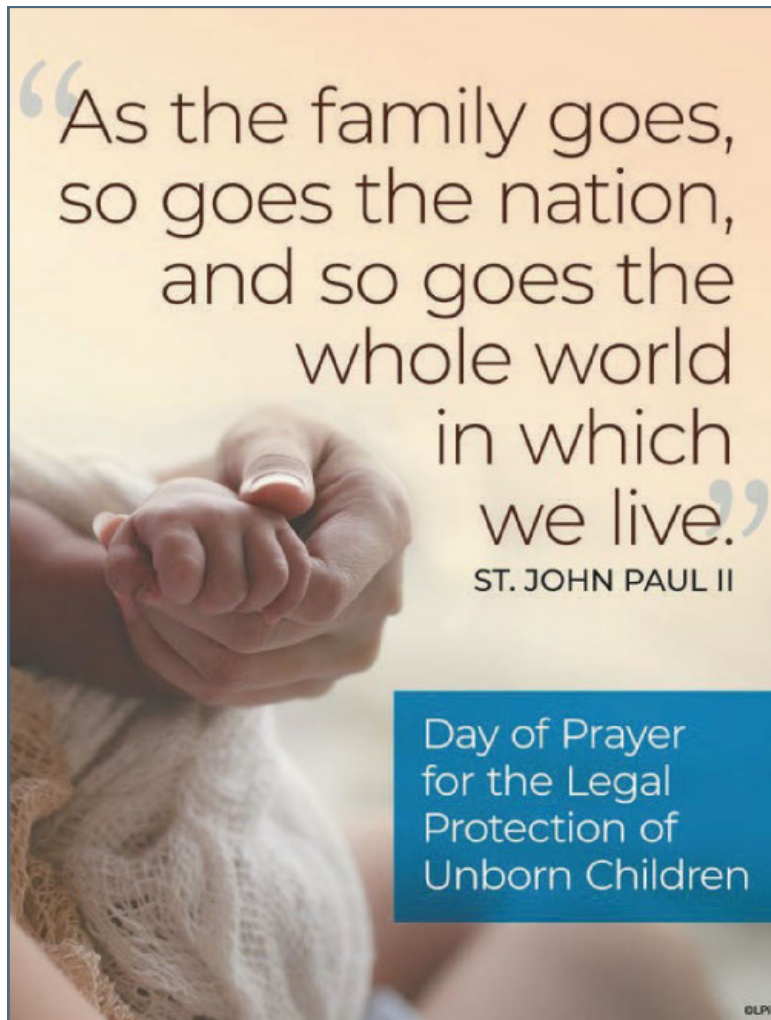

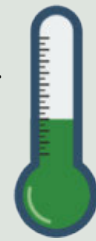

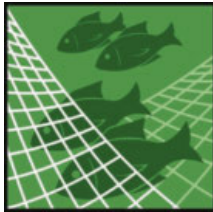
Next week every household in the parish will receive a letter from Bishop Hying asking for your support for the 2023 ACA.
