

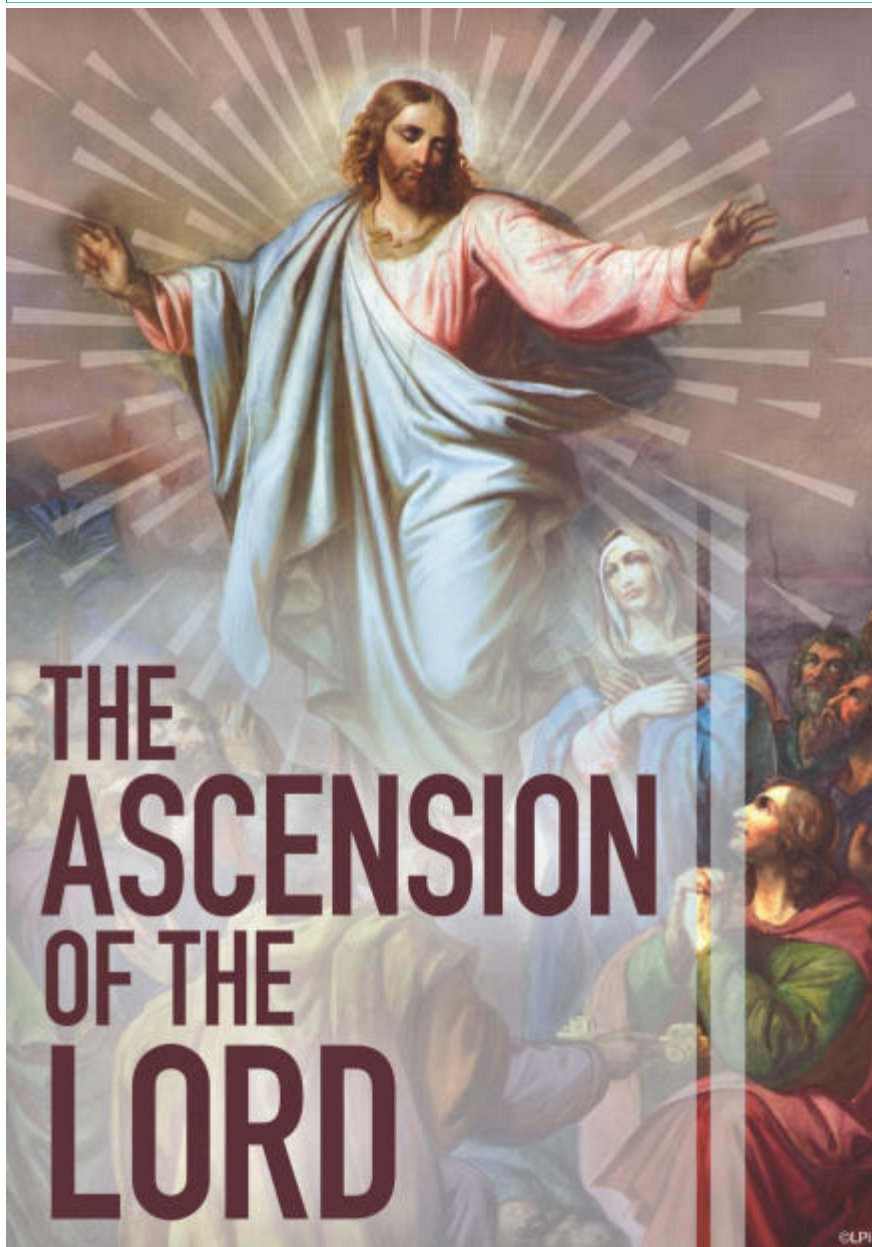

TRUSTEE NOMINATION (Final Notice)

Each year around this time, the selection of a Parish Trustee, one of the positions of the Parish as a legal corporation/entity, takes place. There are two parish trustees, Christopher Gauthier and Lenny Schaefer, each serving renewable two year terms. The term of Chris Gauthier is ending on June 30th.

According to Archdiocesan policy on Trustee Nomination:

- Nominees must be practicing, parish members and at least 25 years old.
- Parish *staff* and permanent deacons are not eligible to serve as trustees.
- Trustees are *ex-officio* members of the pastoral council
- The pastor/Administrator may nominate one (1) candidate per Trustee position open.
- Additional candidates must be nominated in writing by 10 or more parish members.
- If there is more than one candidate, an election will occur in June.

With his consent, I am nominating Chris Gauthier to serve as parish trustee for a term of two years. If anyone else is interested, kindly submit a nomination as per the above stated regulations. Nomination forms are available with Lori Gabert at the parish office.
