

Mary, the Mother of God

When Jesus was dying on the cross, He must have had a reason to entrust His Mother, Mary to John and John to Mary. In this way, Jesus wanted to let us know that He wants Mary to be our mother. Jesus wants us to entrust everything to Him through the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Mary, The Mother of God, is our Mother. Through her intercession and blessing we are granted many graces and gifts, as she is the chosen one through whom God brought the Light to the world. Mary's deepest wish is to protect us and draw us closer to God. Jesus knows well that true devotion to His Mother leads souls to Him. It is very fitting that we celebrate Mother's Day during the Marian month. As we honor the Mother of God, our spiritual mother, we also honor our earthly mothers.
