

God has a plan.




As we read the Ten Commandments, we reflect on how these rules do not take away our freedom, but rather give us the freedom to love.

Religious Education

New RE program begins this fall

Beginning in September, all religious education will be led by parents and supported by the parish in a new program titled, "Family of Faith."



We will host a monthly evening event in which all families come together to learn and pray.

Parents will then lead two lessons for their children in the home during the remainder of the month. There will also be optional social and community building activities.

We will ask all families to volunteer in some capacity throughout the year. More info on volunteering will be available at our first meeting in September.

Family of Faith nights are tentatively scheduled to run from 5:30-7:30 p.m. on Wednesdays. We will begin with an optional meal at 5:30 p.m.

Tentative dates are: Sept. 22, Oct. 6, Nov. 3 and Dec. 1.

Sacramental preparation will remain the same as previous years. It has always been above and beyond standard religious education and those preparing for First Reconciliation and First Communion (typically second grade) and Confirmation (typically tenth grade) will receive schedules for specific formation events.

We are thankful for the 191 families, who have already pledged their support, but this campaign will require participation from all our parish families.


If you have not yet been contacted, please know that we will contact every registered family in the coming weeks.

Last year, with your help, MDCCW sent 750 gift boxes to children throughout Latin American countries.


They hope to be able to meet or beat that goal again this year.

Ask Congress to Act on Climate Change

In 2019, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops issued a statement of support for legislation to address climate change. It's called the **Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act**. Some Diocese and parishes have asked their parishioners to write or call their Congressional Representatives to support the bill. This legislation puts a small but annually increasing fee on fossil fuel energy producers for their carbon emissions. The fee is returned to every American household as a monthly dividend check to offset future fossil fuel price increases. This legislation will trigger massive investments in clean energy, which will quickly become cheaper than fossil fuels, leading to an orderly market transition to non-polluting energy. This will save lives, create jobs, avoid \$\$ Billions in environmental damage while reducing greenhouse gases... without harming the poor or middle class. **This site will help you write a Catholic message and send it to your congressperson:**
