





### Marriage Preparation



This day and the celebrations associated with it have developed into a great appreciation of their gift of self for us.

As Catholics, we have a great appreciation of this reality. Jesus calls each of us to give of ourselves for the well-being of others. This is what it means to be a disciple. In fact, Jesus teaches us through the Gospel of Luke that self-gift is essential for salvation.
