

A note from Father Underwood

Global Synod: In October of 2021, Pope Francis announced a Global Synod that will run through 2023. The purpose of the Synod has been articulated with one word – "listening." In this process, we are listening to each other and to the Holy Spirit.

At first, this sounded a bit vague to me. But, as it comes together, I am appreciating this as a time of sharing our faith. We come to know one another, where we have come from, share what we believe, and grow under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

In Muncie, we will be participating in the Synod with several listening sessions in February and March. Watch the bulletins and Flocknote for more details on how you can participate in one of these listening sessions.

Additionally, we will be praying the Synod Prayer to the Holy Spirit before weekend Masses. The prayer will be available in the pews on printed prayer cards. I have included it here so that you can pray it other times.

Synod Prayer to the Holy Spirit

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful: do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
