FATHER RANDY WRITES . . .

It is at the wedding of Cana that Mary was aware that the wine ran out and she brought that to Jesus. Jesus responds to what Mary noticed. What do you notice lacking in your life? More specifically, where is grief, sorrow, or emptiness part of your life right now? Imitate Mother Mary and offer to Jesus what you notice . . . do not ask for anything, just show Him what you notice. He will do the rest. In this way, your emptiness or hurts can become fountains of joy or places of gratitude as Christ redeems the losses you notice and present to Him.

Mary tells the servants at the wedding in Cana, *“Do whatever he tells you.”* In other words . . . trust him. One of the virtues of the Christian disciple and steward is trust. When we put our trust in at-risk things like jobs, bank accounts, and what we think are our own abilities, we are extremely vulnerable to anxiety and fear. When we put our trust in God, who is the only source of all that we are able to accomplish or accumulate, we enjoy freedom from useless worry. Good stewards trust God explicitly and that enables them to give generously and freely.

Saint Augustine of the 4th century offers:

Every celebration [of the Eucharist] is a celebration of marriage; the Church’s nuptials are celebrated. The King’s Son is about to marry a wife, and the King’s Son [is] himself a King; and the guests frequenting the marriage are themselves the Bride.

The Cross of Marriage

Excerpt from *Love Never Fails* by Bishop Donald Hying: As Christians, we view Jesus as the Divine Bridegroom who came in search of His Bride, the One who turns the plain water of our unredeemed nature into the rich wine of sacred union with God. In wedding homilies, I always liken Jesus’ Cross to a marriage bed, for it is in the Crucifixion that Jesus lays Himself down body, soul, mind, and heart and completely hands His life over for the sake of His Bride, the Church, which Jesus both brings to life and marries through His death and Resurrection.

That means that marriage is a little bit like crucifixion. In marriage, something has to surrender and die so that something greater can come to life. Both husband and wife are called to let go of their individual, self-directed, autonomous lives so that this beautiful new communion of two lives intertwined with each other and wrapped around Christ can come to life. Marriage will never succeed unless both spouses put Christ and the well-being and needs of each other before their own. True love is nourished by sacrifice—a love that gives itself away, a love that lays down its life for the sake of the other. When both spouses heroically strive to live this crucified and risen love of Christ in their marriage, they unleash the creative and saving power of God, even to the point of co-creating with God brand new human beings. Marital fidelity will always be fruitful.

We can also remember the departed in our daily prayers. Just as we have special intentions for family and friends here on earth, we can pray for those who have died. It is also a good act of Christian charity to pray for the forgotten, those who have no one else to pray for them. God knows who they are.

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

God delights in you. How do you feel when you hear that? Delight usually comes with an exuberant flow of joy that seemingly arises

from one's toes with the expression of great glee. Reflecting upon the deep measure of joy God has in us can be a source of joy for ourselves. Delight is infectious. A very young brother and sister were playing on the beach when the all too familiar ice cream truck made its daily rounds. The boy shook with excitement and delight as he took his sister's hand and exclaimed, "The ice cream man is here, isn't it great!" As they ran off toward the truck, one could hear the girl reply, "Yeah, I can't wait!" In spite of the fact that we often wander from the path, God's celebratory delight in us remains. As spouses are asked to remain faithful to each other through whatever life brings, God remains faithful too. This promise remains through this life and into the next. All we have to do is take the advice of Jesus' mother to heart when she says, "Listen to him." This wisdom saves us from foolishly giving in to the illusion that we can make better wine than Jesus.
