

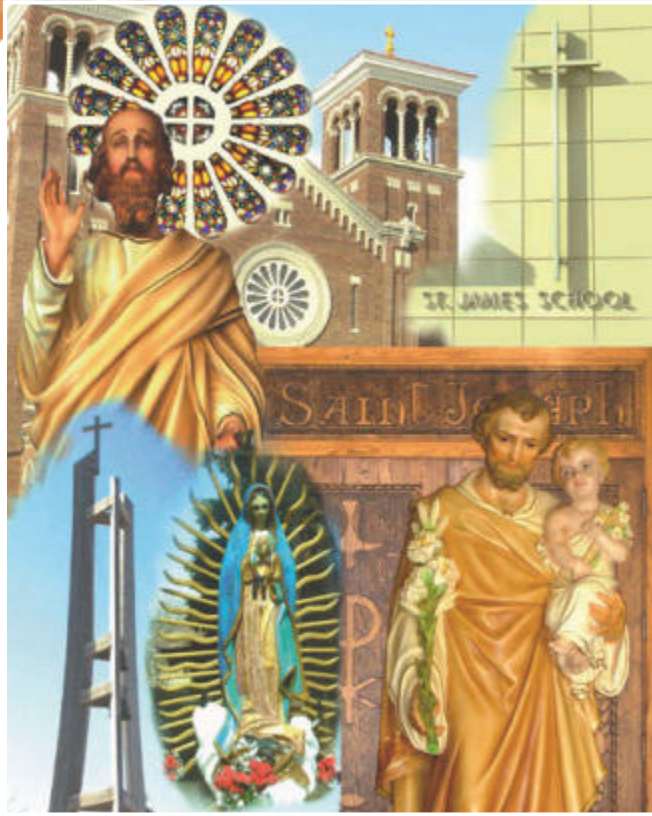

**Cycles of Faith**

"Simon Peter said to them, 'I am going fishing.'" Peter is a favorite apostle for many people. I wonder if it is because of his flawed, relatable humanity. Today's Gospel takes place after Jesus appears to the disciples and breathes the Holy Spirit upon them. And yet, Peter finds himself returning to his old way of life, to comfortable habits he formed long before following Jesus. Is something still lingering in him? Is something still lingering in us? Lent is over, and we should be rejoicing! But do you feel like you're still holding onto something? Or perhaps you had an excellent Lent. You encountered Jesus in a new way and grew in faith. But as the weeks since Easter have slipped by, some of your newfound devotion has begun to waver. The closeness you felt in your Lenten commitments has given way to humdrum status quo or turn-of-the-season busyness.

"Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Peter has endured so much in his walk of discipleship! But something is still weighing on him. In today's Gospel, Jesus confirms Peter's devotion three times, a redemption of his earlier threefold denial. The call of the Lord must come again, as if heard anew for the first time. So often, this is the pattern of the Christian life. We discover God and experience a new desire for our faith, but in time, our enthusiasm begins to wane. Perhaps something happens that startles us, or we startle ourselves by a poor decision. Then we discover God anew! Our joy returns...for a while. Even the Apostles were no strangers to the cyclical nature of spiritual growth. Our disappointments or frustrations should not be cause for giving up. Like Peter, we too can recommit and start anew. This Sunday and every day of our lives, Jesus is waiting to say again, "Follow me."

Jesus said to them, "Come, have breakfast." And none of the disciples dared to ask him, "Who are you?" Because they realized it was the Lord, they came over and took the bread and gave it to them, and he took and ate with them. (John 21:13-14)

### Feed My Sheep Update

Thank you to everyone who participated in our Lenten Service Project, Feed My Sheep, either through your donations or giving of your time to help pack food. Because of your generosity we were able to partner with eight other area Churches on April 6<sup>th</sup> and we packed over 131,000 meals! The meals are being distributed locally at area food pantries, nationally through various mission organizations, and internationally through a mission called "School of the Dumps" in Nicaragua.

### Parish Has Received Rebate from the Diocese for our Success in the Priests for the Future Campaign

As you know our diocese recently had a campaign, Priest for Our Future, to raise funds to pay the tuition for our seminarians preparing for serving our diocese as priests.

Our parish goal was to raise \$480,000. So Far we have collected \$506,843.00. The campaign calls for a parish to receive a rebate for funds collected over goal:

- The funds collected between 100% and 125% of goal calls for the parish to receive 50% of those funds.
- For funds collected beyond 125% of goal, the parish receives 80% of those funds.

We have received \$13,421.50 from the campaign funds that have exceeded our goal. This great rebate is a fine testimony to our parish's commitment to train good and holy priests for the future of our diocese.

If you still owe a part of your pledge to this campaign, we encourage you to make this contribution.

Our parish will continue to receive rebates each quarter as our money collected exceeds our \$480,000. goal.

Many thanks for your great generosity and God bless you for all you do for our parish, diocese and universal church.

**EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP**

May 5, 2019-3rd Sunday of Easter

I am struck by how Jesus addresses the disciples in the 21st chapter of John. They have been fishing all night, and when the dawn comes, Jesus asks, "Children, have you caught anything to eat?" They hadn't caught a thing, so he tells them what to do to finally fill their nets. These children thought they knew best, but they couldn't get the job done until they listened to Jesus. Like a child who needs a parent, these early followers of Jesus were learning that real maturity of faith requires trusting in and listening to the Teacher.

The stewardship way of life demands of us a certain maturity of discipleship. Just as a child is not yet ready to be a parent, an immature disciple may not yet be ready to sacrifice regardless of the cost or understand the true value of his generosity. So every day, we are challenged and called to respond, sometimes even with little cost to ourselves. But each step, no matter how small, brings with it growth. We are growing not only in maturity, but in the ability to trust in God and how to listen for the call as well.

How mature are you in your faith? How much trust do you have in Jesus Christ? How often do you pause to listen to the instructions of your Teacher? The night is now over, and the dawn is upon you. Reflect on the visible fruit of your stewardship, and then listen for the words of Jesus.
