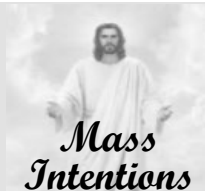

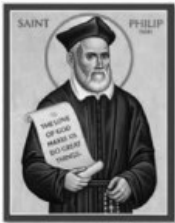

A Heart on Fire!

Most of us know what it's like to have heartburn. It's not a pleasant experience, and unless we can find some antacids, it can be very distressing and debilitating. But what about having your heart "on fire"? That's a different matter altogether.

This coming Thursday, May 26, is the day that we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. It marks 40 days since Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord. The celebration of Ascension has been moved to Sunday, May 29, in many dioceses, including our own. The 40 days that the disciples witnessed the resurrection appearances of Jesus caused their hearts to be on fire. What they couldn't even imagine as possible had happened. Jesus, who was crucified, dead and buried, had resurrected in glory, never to die again. Listen to the words of the two disciples who met Jesus on the road to Emmaus. "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?" (Luke 24:32, ESV-CE).



On this Ascension Thursday we celebrate a beloved saint of the Catholic Church: St. Philip Neri. Fillippo Romolo Neri (1515-1595) is known as the patron of laughter, joy, and comedians. He was by no means a "down-in-the-mouth" Christian. He lived a contagious Christianity that attracted many people to love and follow Jesus. He also understood what it meant to have a heart on fire. On Pentecost of 1544, when he was 29

years old, Philip was absorbed in prayer. At this point in his life, he was not a priest or a religious, but he was absorbed in prayer. Have you ever been absorbed in prayer? Have I? I've been absorbed in a mystery, or a sports event or my hobby, but prayer?

What happened to Philip? While absorbed in prayer, a ball of fire penetrated his chest and made his heart swell so much that it broke two of his ribs! No antacid could remedy that! Nor would you want it to. But rather than think of this as some oddity or some church tale that we repeat about the saints, Philip's life was marked from that point on building on his conversion eleven years earlier and his continual love and service to others.

Because of his deep love of Jesus and the powerful presence of the Holy Spirit in his life he was always gathering around himself young people who saw in Philip something worth living for and even dying for. Philip brought them to the faith and to the Eucharist. They spent their time reading, talking, praying, singing, and even playing. Philip would often say to these energetic young folks, "Be happy, it's enough for me that you do not sin!"

Philip did not become a priest until he was 36 years old, but that is not when his life of evangelization began. It only continued in a different way to the point that he is now known as the second apostle of Rome.

St. Philip Neri, pray for us that we will be "happy" and "on fire" for Christ to make a difference in our world!

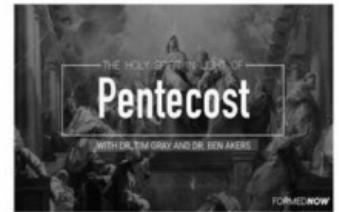

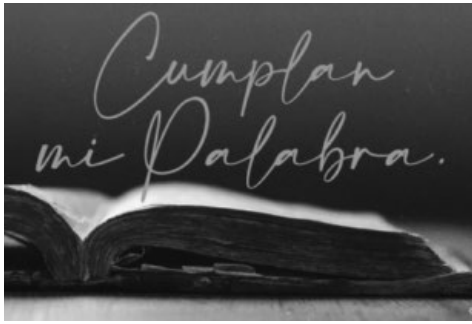

Nuestra tarea: siempre tener la esperanza de enseñar y recordar todo lo que hemos recibido de Dios a los que nos rodean.

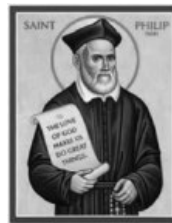

¡Un corazón en llamas!

La mayoría de nosotros sabemos lo que es tener acidez estomacal. No es una experiencia agradable y, a menos que podamos encontrar algunos antiácidos, puede ser muy angustiante y debilitante. Pero, ¿qué hay de tener el corazón "en llamas"? Eso es un asunto completamente diferente. Este próximo jueves 26 de mayo es el día en que celebramos la Ascensión del Señor. Se cumplen 40 días desde el Domingo de Resurrección de la Resurrección del Señor. La celebración de la Ascensión se ha trasladado al domingo 29 de mayo en muchas diócesis, incluida la nuestra. Los 40 días que los discípulos presenciaron las apariciones de resurrección de Jesús hicieron que sus corazones ardieran. Lo que ni siquiera podían imaginar como posible había sucedido. Jesús, quien fue crucificado, muerto y sepultado, había resucitado en gloria, para nunca más morir. Escucha las palabras de los dos discípulos que se encontraron con Jesús en el camino a Emaús. "¿No ardía nuestro corazón dentro de nosotros mientras nos hablaba en el camino, mientras nos abría las Escrituras?" (Lucas 24:32, NVI-CE).



En este Jueves de Ascensión celebramos a un santo amado de la Iglesia Católica: San Felipe Neri. Filippo Romolo Neri (1515-1595) es conocido como el patrón de la risa, la alegría y los comediantes. Él no era de ninguna manera un cristiano "aburrido". Vió un cristianismo contagioso que atrajo a muchas personas a amar y seguir a Jesús.

También entendió lo que significaba tener un corazón en llamas. En Pentecostés de 1544, cuando tenía 29 años, Felipe estaba absorto en la oración. En este momento de su vida, no era sacerdote ni religioso, pero estaba absorto en la oración.

¿Qué le pasó a Felipe? ¡Mientras estaba absorto en la oración, una bola de fuego penetró en su pecho e hizo que su corazón se hinchara tanto que le rompió dos costillas! ¡Ningún antiácido podría remediarlo! Ni te gustaría que lo hiciera. Pero en lugar de pensar en esto como una rareza o un cuento eclesialístico que repetimos sobre los santos, la vida de Felipe estuvo marcada desde ese momento sobre la base de su conversión once años antes y su continuo amor y servicio a los demás.

Por su profundo amor a Jesús y la poderosa presencia del Espíritu Santo en su vida, siempre reunía a su alrededor a jóvenes que veían en Felipe algo por lo que valía la pena vivir e incluso morir. Felipe los llevó a la fe ya la Eucaristía. Pasaron su tiempo leyendo, hablando, orando, cantando e incluso jugando. Felipe les decía a menudo a estos jóvenes enérgicos: "¡Sé feliz, me basta con que no peques!" Felipe no se hizo sacerdote hasta los 36 años, pero no fue entonces cuando comenzó su vida de evangelizador. Solo continuó de una manera diferente hasta el punto de que ahora se le conoce como el segundo apóstol de Roma. ¡San Felipe Neri, ruega por nosotros para que seamos "felices" y "ardientes" por Cristo para hacer una diferencia en nuestro mundo!
