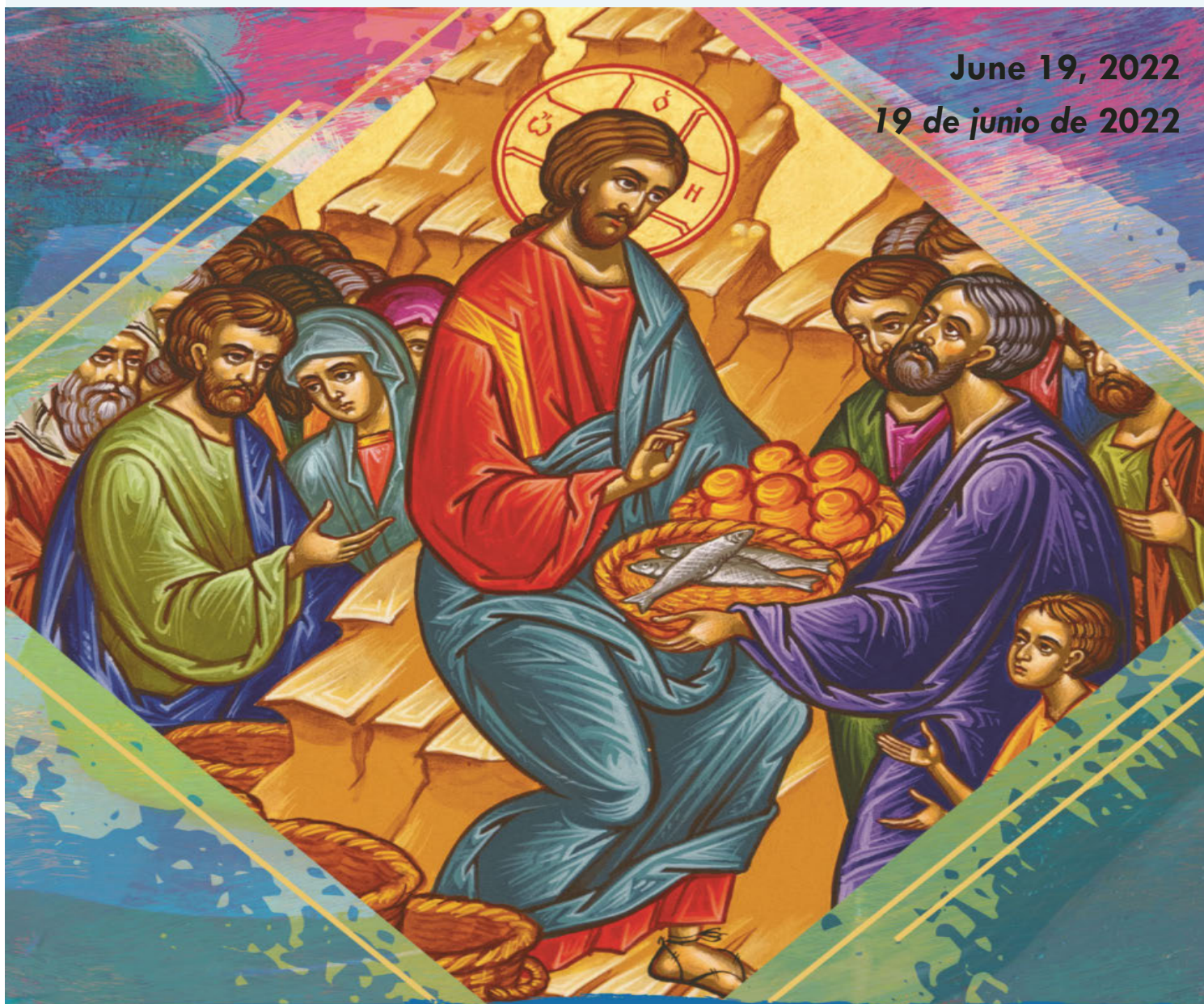

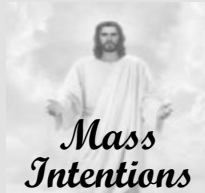

Reflecting our Eucharistic Lord

Someone once said to St. Teresa of Ávila, "If only I had lived at the time of Jesus...If only I had seen Jesus...If only I had talked with Jesus." Teresa responded, "But do we not have in the Eucharist the living, true and real Jesus present before us. Why look for more?"



St. Thomas Aquinas tells us, "O precious and wonderful banquet that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as food" (Feast of Corpus Christi. Cited in Liturgy of Hours, Vol III, p. 610).

These saints, among many others, were devoted to the Mass and to devotions associated with the Eucharist. Devotions to the Eucharist are invitations to prayer and contemplation. On Holy Thursday, after Jesus had transformed bread and wine into his Body and Blood and given the Apostles their First Communion, he proceeded to invite them to prayerful union with him. As they look at him and the chalice in front of them, they heard him say, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing" (Jn 15:5). They had received the Sacrament, but they had to live in faith-filled union with Christ so they could serve others. Prayer would help them do this.

Placing yourself before the tabernacle is a commitment to be a sturdier branch on the vine, a healthier member of Christ's Body, a heart open to the unseen power of prayer. Prayerful participation in the Mass needs the support of eucharistic devotional prayer to keep alive the continuing relationship with Christ. The branches need the vine. Devotional, meditative prayer is one way to do this.

Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen believed that his daily hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament was essential for his ministry as a priest. "The Holy Hour became like an oxygen tank to revive the breath of the Holy Spirit" (Treasure in Clay, p. 202). Sheen constantly promoted meditative prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. "We become like that which we gaze upon. Looking into a sunset, the face takes on a golden glow. Looking at our Eucharistic Lord for an hour transforms the heart in a mysterious way" (Sheen, p. 198).

I conclude with a few practices for parents and catechists to foster eucharistic devotions:

1. Regularly attend weekend Mass with the family. Come for prayer before and after Mass.
2. Adore the raised Body and Blood of Christ at Mass with the silent phrase, "My Lord and my God."
3. Participate in eucharistic adoration where possible.
4. Genuflect with reverence before the Blessed Sacrament.
5. Make visits to the Blessed Sacrament altar individually and with whole family.
6. Engage family in regular Scripture study and catechesis on the Eucharist.
7. Read lives of eucharistic saints such as St. Katharine Drexel and St. John Neumann.

Adoration

"The most powerful thing we can do on this earth with our time is to spend it in Eucharistic adoration. Nothing can do more to change the world, to bring about peace, to convert hearts, to make reparation for the many evils committed. Our world is in desperate need of hope, of renewal, of a 'turning back' to the things of God. By visiting Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, we take up the best weapon for the battles of our age and contribute to the healing of our culture. Cultivating a Eucharistic life of adoration also bears tremendous fruit in our own hearts and lives. We cannot spend time in the rays of His Eucharistic Presence without receiving His grace, His love, His mercy, His peace. As we gaze upon Him Face to face, we are transformed little by little into a closer reflection of His divine image." — Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration

El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Fue el Papa Urbano IV que instituyó la festividad del Corpus Christi en el año 1264. Desde entonces hasta nuestros días, la Iglesia con gran fervor celebra junto con sus

fieles esta Solemnidad. “La fiesta de Corpus Christi nos pide convertirnos a la fe en la Providencia, saber compartir lo poco que somos y tenemos y no cerrarnos nunca en nosotros mismos. La Eucaristía es el memorial del amor de Dios. Ahí se celebra el memorial de la pasión, del amor de Dios por nosotros, que es nuestra fuerza, el apoyo para nuestro caminar”... El Señor, no se olvida de nosotros y cada vez que vamos a él nos conforta con amor” (Papa Francisco).

¿Qué tal está el amor a la Eucaristía en mí? ¿Cuándo comulgo, lo hago con respeto y agradecimiento? La Eucaristía es un pan para sobrevivir, para ayudar al más necesitado. Las palabras de Jesús en el Evangelio tienen mucho de este compromiso de compartir. “Denles ustedes mismos de comer” (Lucas 9:11). Sentimiento de solidaridad en nosotros, los seguidores de Jesús. Forma parte de la esencia de la fe, tanto en la sociedad como en la comunidad. Y, el Evangelio nos dice: “Todos comieron hasta saciarse. Después se recogieron los pedazos que habían sobrado, y llenaron doce canastos (Lucas 9:17). 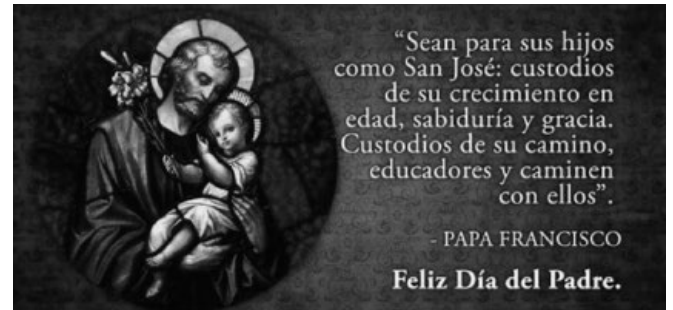
¡Bienvenida, Heidi!
