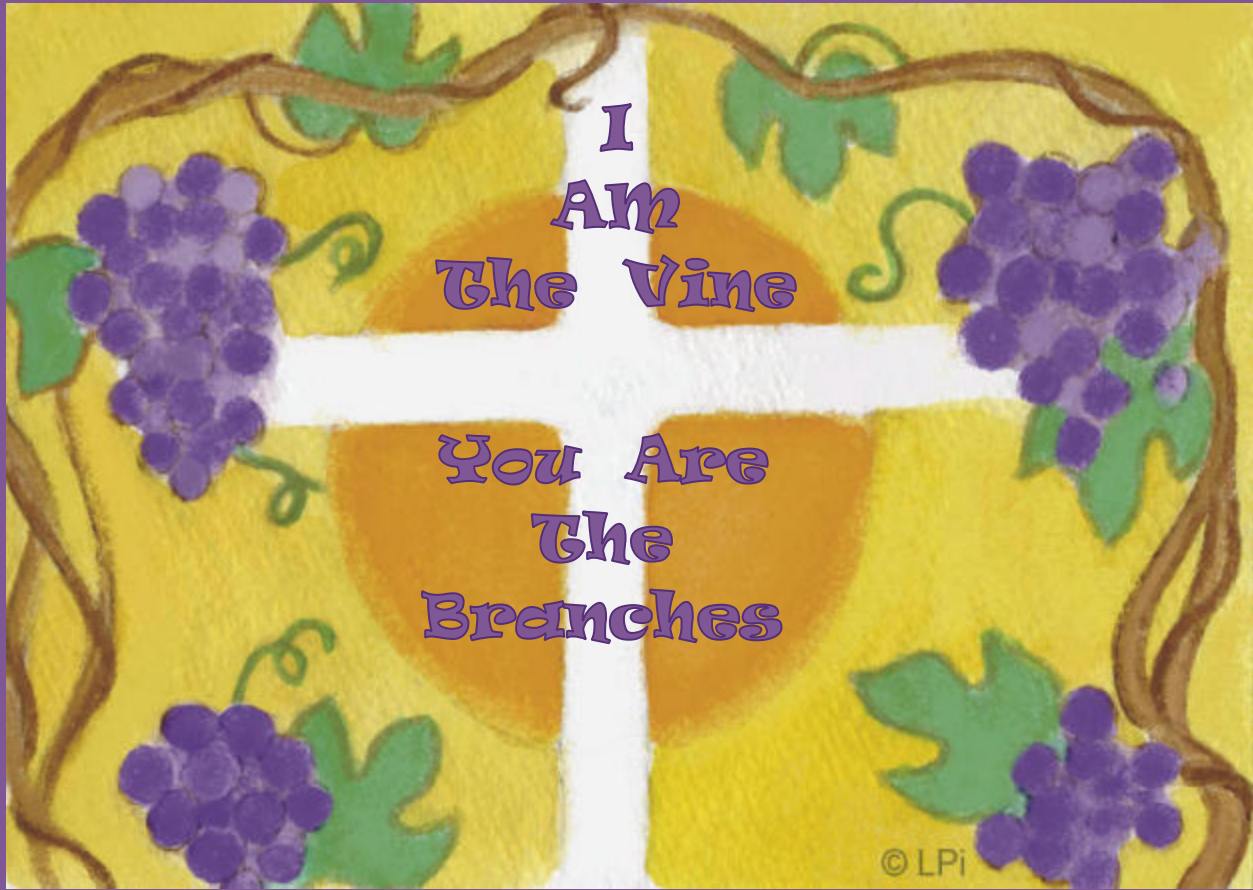

**Today's Easter Theme**

Jesus was so attuned to nature.

Something of God's living, giving and dynamic self surrounds and envelops our lives.

**SUNDAY'S READINGS**

*Excerpts to think about*

**First Reading**

*When Saul arrived in Jerusalem he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him, not believing that he was a disciple. (Acts 9:26)*

Luke tells us how the conversion of Saul (Paul) and the acceptance by the disciples of him helped facilitate peace in the Church throughout Judea, Galilee, & Samaria. What do you think is needed to bring peace in our Church today?

**Second Reading**

*And his commandment is this:*

*we should believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and love one another just as he commanded us. (1 Jn 3:23)*  
John teaches his community that believing in Jesus and loving one another is the heart of God's commandment. How good are you at following this two-fold command?

**Gospel**

*“I am the vine, you are the branches.*

*Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing.” (Jn 15:5)*

Using the metaphor of a vine and branches, Jesus urges his disciples to “remain in me” in order to bear good fruit and thereby glorify God. What would be some examples of “good fruit” that you have produced?
