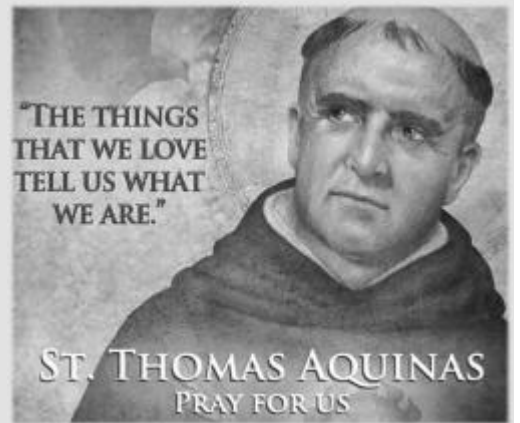

## Feed Me

In our daily lives, what are we feeding ourselves? We could look at ourselves physically through nutrition to see what we take in is either good or bad. If we take in too many sugary treats and not enough nutritious food that helps in good body growth, this would be bad for us to maintain good health. The same is with our spiritual health. What are we feeding ourselves? What are we taking in by what we read, see on TV, in the movies, or hear in our music? By what we take in, is this leading us to a closer relationship with God the Father? Or are the things we bring in or we allow in, taking us further away from God?

These are good questions to ask ourselves, because it can help us to see where we are in our spiritual life and realize what needs to change or where we need to grow in our relationship with God and be attentive to His voice in our life that we may do His will and not our own. How are we starving ourselves from the grace we need to grow spiritually in our relationship with the Beloved?

We need to take in good spiritual material that can help aid us in prayer and understanding our Catholic faith and traditions, so we can pass on or explain to others goods we have in our Catholic faith. But most of all, we become a living witness of our faith by our actions. One may claim they believe in God but their actions in what they do, think or say are completely opposite from what they profess. This does not mean we lack or fail in a virtue at one time or another. It is those that keep claiming "I'm a believer in God." and still promote and support things that are wicked or do actions contrary to God.



**HOW DO YOU PRAY THE LECTIO DIVINA?**

Lectio Divina is a practice of scriptural reading. It involves meditating on a passage of the Bible, preferably the Gospel of the day.

**Steps to pray:**

- 1. INVOKE**  
Invite the Holy Spirit to guide the reading of the Scripture.
- 2. READ**  
Ask yourself: What is this passage saying? If you can, use a Bible commentary.
- 3. MEDITATE**  
In a moment of silence, try to listen to the voice of God.
- 4. PRAY**  
Begin to dialogue with the Lord and open yourself to his will.
- 5. CONTEMPLATE**  
Listen closely with your heart and put into practice what he has told you.

This is why spiritual books, listening to catholic programs on TV or radio, retreats, bible studies, adoration, daily Mass, prayer groups, and so on can help us to grow and become stronger spiritually. So we can know and love the truth of God and make prudent decisions against those who do not. But we need to be fed. We need the desire to want to be fed.

Here are a few books that may help you on your journey and I hope to put other books or material that will help you grow in the faith: *The Art of Praying* by Romano Guardini; *Union with God According to St. John of the Cross* by Fr. Gabriel of St. Mary Magdalen; *The Imitation of Christ* by Thomas a Kempis. These are just a few but I know of many more and will find ways to get more titles in the bulletin and on the parish web page.
