Join us in prayer Tuesday, July 13th at 6:30pm in Mary's Garden at Holy Rosary (behind the Rectory) to pray the Rosary.

Story of Fatima, the month of July 1917... By July 13th so many people have heard about a heavenly Lady appearing in Fatima and about four thousand people come to the Cova de Ria to see the what was happening. Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta prayed the rosary then the Blessed Mother appeared. Lucia asked... 'What do you want of me and could you perform a miracle so that people would believe that you are appearing to us?' Our Lady responded; 'I want you to come here on the thirteenth of next month. Continue to pray the rosary every day in order to obtain peace for the world. In October, I will tell you who I am and what I want, and there will be a miracle for all to see and believe. Sacrifice yourselves for sinners and pray; O Jesus, it is for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.'

As the Lady was speaking, rays of light came from her hands and broke open the earth. The children saw a frightening vision of hell. It was a sea of fire and within it were souls and demons who burned as red hot coals. The children in fear looked to the Lady and she said; 'You have seen hell where poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world Devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. The war is going to end; but if people keep offending God, a worse war will break out during the reign of Pius XI, on a night illumined by an unknown light, know it will be a sign given by God that He is about to punish the world for its sins and crimes, by means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and of the Holy Father.

In order to prevent this, I ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart and of reparation to be made on the First Saturdays of the month. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted and there will be peace; if not, Russia will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecution of the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will suffer much, various nations will be annihilated. But in the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me and Russia will be converted and a period of peace will be granted to the world. In Portugal, the dogma of the Faith will always be preserved.'

After this an angel with a flaming sword appeared next to the Lady, as he cried out; 'Penance, Penance, Penance!' The children saw a vision of the Holy Father climbing a steep mountain with a cross at the top. Many people were following him: bishops, priests, religious and lay people. The Holy Father went through the city that was in ruins, praying for people who had died there. At the top of the mountain, he fell on his knees at the cross and was killed by soldiers. All of the people following the pope were also killed when they reached the cross. As they died, two angels gathered the blood of these martyrs and sprinkled it on the souls journeying to God. The Lady warned the children; 'Do not tell this to anybody. She wanted them to keep all that they had seen a secret. The Lady said; 'When you pray the rosary, say after each mystery: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins and save us from the fire of hell. Lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.' Then our Lady ascended up to Heaven. The children were frightened by this vision, but they obeyed what they promised the Lady and did not tell anyone about the visions they saw that day in July.

These secrets were only told to the Pope and were written down and kept secret in the archives of the Vatican. Each new pope was given the secrets to read. This message was made known by St. John Paul II in the jubilee year 2000 as he canonized Francisco and Jacinta the first children saints of the new millennium. This message shows that all of us have a key role in helping to save souls, by praying the rosary and offering up sacrifices, to repair for our own sins and the sins of other people.
