Be Studious

In the last bulletin we talked about humility and its opposite pride. Now let us look at the virtue of studiousness. What is virtue of studiousness? It is that virtue which makes man control in conformity with right reason the desire to know and to learn. It is not a sin to want to grow in knowledge and understanding when coupled together with right reason. Meaning that one does not need to know everything. Fulton Sheen writes that we “live in a world in which the worldly wise say: ‘You do not know life; you have never lived.’ They assume that you can know nothing except by experience – experience not only of good but of evil.”

This desire to know everything is the vice of curiosity. This is the inordinate desire to know what one has no right to know, or to know what may prove a source of danger to virtue owing to one’s weakness. Adam and Eve desire to eat of the tree of good and Eve originates from pride, but the desire to know what God knows in evil as well as good is curiosity. Adam and Eve knew the good but now they know evil and we as offspring of our first parents have regretted knowing ever since.

The more we know does not equate to wisdom and make us freer people. Our curiosity to know can lead us into things we may have a hard time turning away from. Sheen tells us to “examine your own life. If you know evil by experience, are you wiser because of it? Have you not despised that very evil and are you not the more tragic for having experienced it? You may even have become mastered by the evil you have experienced.” Don’t we say at times: “I wish I didn’t experience this or that.” “I wish I have never done that.”

Sad is that our education system teaches us the more we know the less evil will be in the world because we are not ignorant of evil. Fulfill and know all your curiosities and you will be wise. If true, Sheen states that “we should be the most virtuous people in the history of the world, because we are the best educated.” However, it is the opposite. “Never before has there been so much education and never before so little coming to the knowledge of truth. We forget that ignorance is better than error.”

The Blessed Virgin Mary is the greatest model of studiousness, because she was ignorant of evil. She never seeks out the knowledge of evil. Curiosity never had the best of her. She only needed to know and learn what was going to get her closer to God where the truth lies. It is seeking what is truly important and discarding the rest. That means taking in too much news, what we read in novels, what we see on TV and in the movies, or what we listen in our music can be fostered by curiosity, where studiousness uses prudence in what one person takes in and how that will lead oneself to a holier life. God make us more studious people that we seek what is God and desire to be ignorant in what is evil.
