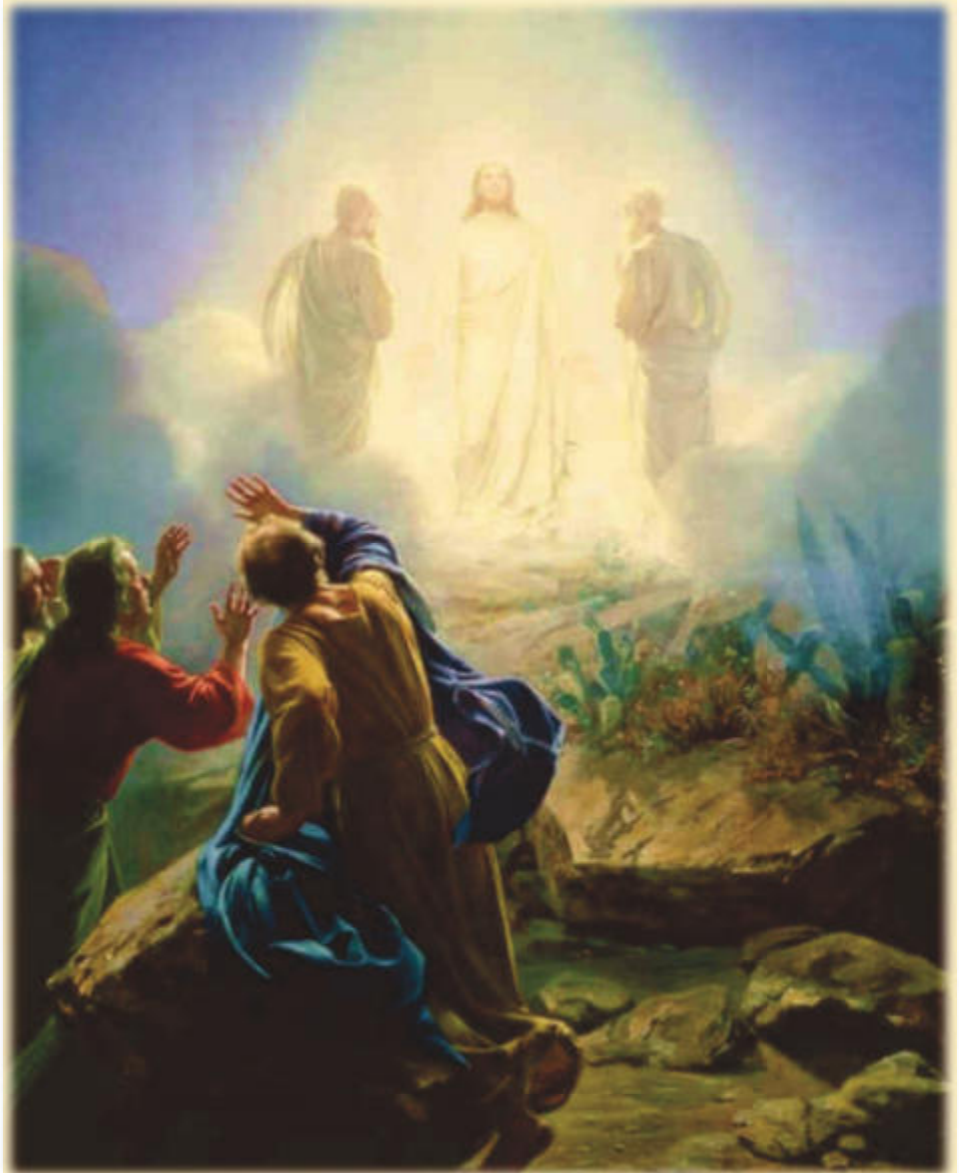

## Modesty

As we have looked at virtues of humility and studiousness, now we are going to look at the virtue of modesty. Under the cardinal virtue of temperance, modesty is what restrains the sensitive appetite in things less difficult to be regulated, like one's own excellence, the desire to know, our outwardly actions of the body, and one's exterior as regards to the manner of dress.

We have gone through two of the virtues, humility and studiousness, and the third is modesty as well but the strict sense of the word. Modesty under the strict sense is the perfection in the sensitive appetite which makes everything in a person's exterior as regards to his movements, gestures, words, the tone of his voice, and his general attitude, to be what it ought to be according to the statue of the person, and this in such a way that nothing whatsoever is offensive in his conduct; on this head modesty is akin to friendship and truthfulness.

Just having been with my nephew and nieces, here is an example of the type of modesty we corrected. Not to say what they were doing was evil, but was not modest. At times in the restaurant, my nephew would get excited about something and my sister would correct him in using an indoor voice. He was not being obnoxious, but let his feelings of excitement get the best of him. Once calmed down, he was reminded that he is not the only one in the restaurant and that others were dining as well. This is working on modesty in tone of voice and even movements and gestures that are required for being in restraint. Now when he is at the park that same excitement shown at the restaurant, would be acceptable.

Modesty goes with one's status of a person. I expect certain things out of a five-year-old but not out of adults. The same with a priest or someone in a religious order. If I were to wear or say something inappropriate, it would cause shock or scandal around me because I didn't live up to the standard of my status. But in the end, we are all made in the image and likeness of God and we have a standard of modesty to follow. Certain principles and disciplines to follow that one can be free to act like themselves.

Unfortunately, the majority of clothing and fashion of today do not follow the dignity of the human person. This is a problem for females and also at times now with males. We have been desensitized to the sense of modesty by what we see in magazines, TV, and movies. Do we act and dress modesty to our status as sons and daughters of God? How I act, speak, and dress, is it in line with the virtue of modesty or do I see my pride being injured or my so called rights and freedom being suppressed? The world says these things and makes claims of injustice, but what they promote is an injustice because it goes against the virtue and promotes the vice. I found it to be a virtue of studiousness in seeking the truth on modesty, for the ones that created this website sought out answers to their questions on modesty. I encourage the Holy Rosary family to check this out, especially the young adults and higher. Remember modesty is akin to friendship and truthfulness.
