

Story of Fatima August 1917

Just before the children were going to go the Cova de Ria, the mayor of the district came to their home and offered to give the children a ride to the Cova in his own wagon. The children went with him but he took them in the opposite direction towards the city of Ourem about nine miles' way. There he tried to get the children to say that they we relying and making all these stories up.

The mayor tried to bribe the children into telling him the secrets and when they would not tell, he then began to threatened them saying he was going to throw them into a pot of billing oil. Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta were brave and would into tell him anything. One by one the children had to stand in front of him being questioned. Then he threw them in jail overnight and was surprised to find them kneeling and praying the rosary with all of the prisoners. Two days later, he took the children home.

On August 19th Lucia, Francisco and his brother John were tending their sheep in a pasture close to where the Archangel Might had appeared to them a year earlier. It was late afternoon and Lucia gave John a few coins to go tell Jacinta to come. As soon as Jacinta arrived the Lady appeared.

Lucia asked, 'What do you want of me?' Our Lady responded; 'I want you to continue going to the Cova da Ira on the thirteenth and continue to pray the Rosary every day. In October, I will perform a miracle so that all may believe.'

Lucia asked; 'What do you want done with the money the people leave in the Cova?' Mary responded; 'Have two litters made. One to be carried by you and Jacinta and two other girls dressed in white; the other is to be carried by Francisco and three other boys. The money for the litters is for the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, and what is left over will go towards building a chapel on that spot.'

Lucia asked for the cure of some sick people. The Lady said; 'Yes, I will cure some this year.' Then she looked very sad and said; 'Pray, pray very much and make sacrifices for sinners; for many souls go to hell, because there are none to sacrifice themselves and to pray for them.' Then the Lady left, disappearing into the east as before.
