

# Please join us to pray the Fatima Rosary, Monday, September 13th at 6:30 pm in the Mary Garden, behind the Rectory.

September 13, 1917...

Despite the mayor's attempts to prove that the children were lying, news of the apparitions in Fatima was spreading all over the country of Portugal. There were so many people coming to Fatima that it was hard for the children to walk to the Cova de Iria from their homes. People began to help the children by shouting out: 'Make way for the visionaries! Let's clear a path for them to walk through the crowds.'

There was a flash of light and the Blessed Mother appeared, just as she had before. Mary told them: "Continue to pray the Rosary every day in order to obtain the end of the war." Then she spoke about the miracle Lucia had asked for. "In October, Our Lord will come, as well as Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of Mount Carmel. St. Joseph will appear with the Child Jesus to bless the world."

The children had taken on a penance to save souls and for the conversion of sinners by wearing a rope around their waist. Our Lady told them that: "God is pleased with your sacrifices, but He does not want you to sleep with the rope on around your waist, only wear it in the daytime." Lucia said: "I was told to ask you many things... For the cure of some sick people, of a deaf-mute boy..." Mary gently said: "Yes, I will cure some, but not others, it is necessary for them to ask forgiveness of their sins. In October I will perform a miracle so that all may believe that I have come here." Then the Lady disappeared.

The main points of this apparition is...

As we seek to live in relationship with God, we grow in grace and repair for sin. And our efforts become even more powerful for saving souls when we offer them to Jesus through the heart of His Mother! As Mary promised at Fatima, "My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God."




