

Jesus is our Light

When we look at renaissance art or art around that period, we need to know that the artist is going to give you more than just a picture to ooh and augh at. The painting on the front cover of the bulletin is the *Nativity* by Antonio da Correggio. When we look at the painting, we see the usual characters: the infant Jesus, Mary, Joseph in the background, and this time we have the shepherds and the angels.

What is one thing you may see that stands out? Take a second to look at the picture. Where is the light coming from? Is it coming from a lantern or a torch that shines on all the characters? Hopefully you realize the artist is having the source of light coming from the infant Jesus. Why Jesus? It is nighttime, he could have had stars or the moon to give off the light for the scene. But he doesn't. Why is Jesus illuminated? Because Jesus is the light of the world. The artist points us all to Revelation where it says: "And night shall be no more; they (his servants) need no lights of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they shall reign for ever and ever" (Rev. 22:5). Jesus is the light of the world. The artist combines in this painting when God comes to earth to take on human flesh and towards the future of who Jesus will be to us for all eternity.

What we can gain from this painting as well, that Jesus is the light amidst the darkness. We know it is nighttime but there is no other light to be seen, for Jesus is the only true light we need. Especially with evils and darkness of this world. From natural disasters, pestilence and disease, sexually impurity and promiscuity, people choosing what sex they want to be, following Marxism and the list goes on; we live in a very dark place. Just like the Israelites and the Jews were going through dark times, but Jesus was the light that they had been waiting for to lead them out of their darkness. "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil; for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff, they comfort me" (Ps. 23:4), for Jesus is the guiding light, the shepherd. Jesus is the truth that exposes lies and deception of sin. He brings the truth, the goodness, and the light. We are gazing on the child as Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds are in this picture always. He is going to bring and lead us out of the darkness in our own lives when we let the light of Christ be within us.

God had done this through the sacrament of Baptism that cleanses us of our sins (darkness) so we can receive the Eucharist (Jesus the light). We can also receive God by being in His presence as we pray in front of the tabernacle or the monstrance. Allowing Jesus to radiate His light of grace in us so that His light may shine on to others through us. May all of you receive the gift of Jesus as the light of truth and glory this Christmas Season to break free from the darkness of sin in this world.


