

Say What You Mean

Words have meaning. We can say, "Well that is obvious." Then how could we ever communicate with each other or express ourselves? Words have to mean something. What I am pointing out is do we think of what we are saying and do we believe what we say? What do I mean? At times while I am driving in my vehicle and a song comes on the radio, I will sing to the tune I know. However, when I am singing, that doesn't mean I am really paying attention to what I am singing. I could be thinking of something else at the same time. One reason (and there could be more) is that I have come to know the song so well it becomes habit or routine; I don't have to think, I just do. This could be anything. Think of any action you have done over and over again and how you may do this without thinking. It would be like the keys to my house. I just have to look at the key and I know this is the one for the house. However, I now have a different set of keys from the ones I had before for the house, and I have to stop and really focus on which key I have to use because they are not the same.

The same can be for Mass. for you in the pews as well as for the celebrant. We all can hit a routine, for we have been doing this for many years. Father says *this*, then I say *that*. We have the routine on what we say. The Nicene Creed is a good example. We have been saying it for a long time and we get to the point where we do not even have to think; we are just saying the words. Even as priests, we have to watch out when we say Mass that we do not hit autopilot. We need to take the time and think of what we are saying and hopefully, mean what we say. When a song or hymn is sung, it is different from one who recites words compared to one who sings it from the heart. That is why many of the Sacred Music is psalms set to music or truths of God that we pray for His glory. So when we sing the hymns at Mass, we can make them our own and give our praise to God. Also, the responses at Mass, like the Amen. Amen means: *I believe*. So for example, when you come up to communion to receive Jesus, Father says "Body of Christ" and you respond, "Amen." But it should not be said as a response, like saying the answer four, to the question two plus two. The answer should be with convictions. I believe what Father said, that it is Jesus in that host. However, many do not respond as they should and come up as a routine motion. This is where we need to be aware, think and believe what we are saying. We need to say what we mean, but most of all, truly believe what we are saying. This will only increase our love for God and a greater experience at Mass because we are communicating from the heart to God.




