

Can Your Family Help Feed Hungry Kids?

Did you know that nearly 13% of the children in Warrick County suffer from food insecurity?

Food insecurity refers to the USDA's measure of lack of access, at times, to enough food for an active, healthy life for all household members and limited or uncertain availability of nutritionally adequate foods. Food insecure children are those living in households experiencing food insecurity.

Food insecure households are not necessarily food insecure all the time. Food insecurity may reflect a household's need to make trade-offs between important basic needs, such as housing or medical bills, and purchasing nutritionally adequate foods.

Our Parish is Responding

Each week of the school year, **St. John the Baptist is providing bags of food** to Warrick County school children that face food insecurity. These bags are filled with shelf-stable, healthy food items. They are given to children discreetly to take home for the weekend.

We Could Use Your Help!

We are currently providing nearly **100 bags of food each week** to 3 Warrick Co. Schools. The parish orders the food, bags are assembled, and then bags are delivered to the three schools on Friday morning. **The cost for food each week** is around \$550.

- Sign up to put food bags together in the Parish Office or at your home on Wed or Thurs. Food can be delivered to you if needed.
- Deliver filled bags of food to the schools.


