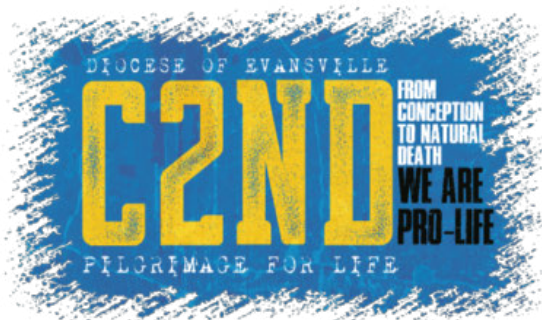


C2ND RESOURCES

LOST AND FOUND

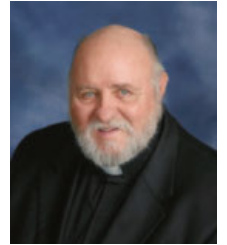

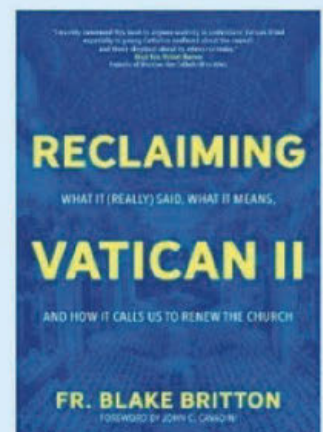

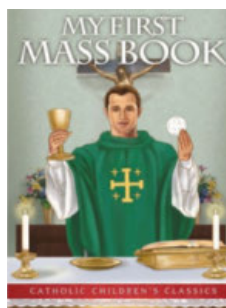
