

From the Pastor


On August 15, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On that Holy Day, we celebrate that Mary was assumed at the end of her earthly life directly into heaven. Besides early Church Fathers, one of the best proofs that we have for this belief is actually the lack of evidence, in other words, we know where the bones of all of the great early saints were located, but there are no claims from anyone saying they have Mary's body in a tomb.

Did you know that every mother retains some DNA from each of their children in their bodies? From a physical standpoint, it makes sense why Mary would be assumed directly into heaven, her body contained Divine DNA. From a spiritual standpoint it makes sense as well, because we believe that Mary was full of grace, that she was saved from original sin at the moment of her conception and thus there was no need for her to die or to be buried, her body was already incorruptible because she had no stain of sin. From a human standpoint, we love our mother's with a very strong love that would do anything for them, so if you were also God, like Jesus, and had the ability to take your mom directly into heaven, wouldn't you?

We celebrate Mary our Mother as a great saint, a great model of holiness, and a great intercessor for us. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, but I hope that people look at it less as an obligation and more as an opportunity to grow in holiness. Please make time to come to Mass for this opportunity at one of three times, the Vigil on Wednesday, August 14 at 5:30pm, and then 6:30am or noon on Thursday.
