Thanks for all of your prayers for a safe and relaxing vacation. The mission was accomplished, our friend Johnathan from seminary was validly married, with eleven priests being present for the Mass! It was a beautiful celebration, and I was able to catch up with many friends.



I returned in just time for our finance council meeting on Tuesday night. As you can see, we are ahead on our budget for the year, and rather than wait until the end of the fiscal year, we decided to pay off the remainder of this loan #1781 which was given to us on 3/20/2003 for Operations/HFCS Assessment. Typically, we just use RED fund money, but as we have surplus, we like to pay it off. We have made some good progress since our "peak debt" in 2011 of \$1,025,335, but we still have a way to go, with our other loans totaling \$575,000. We will continue to use surplus to pay down the debt.

This week I celebrate my anniversary, four years as a priest! It's been a great four years, not without it's challenges, but I have learned a lot. Thank you for your support, and please pray for Ben Valentine (pictured at right) who will be ordained Saturday at the Cathedral. - Fr. Andy


