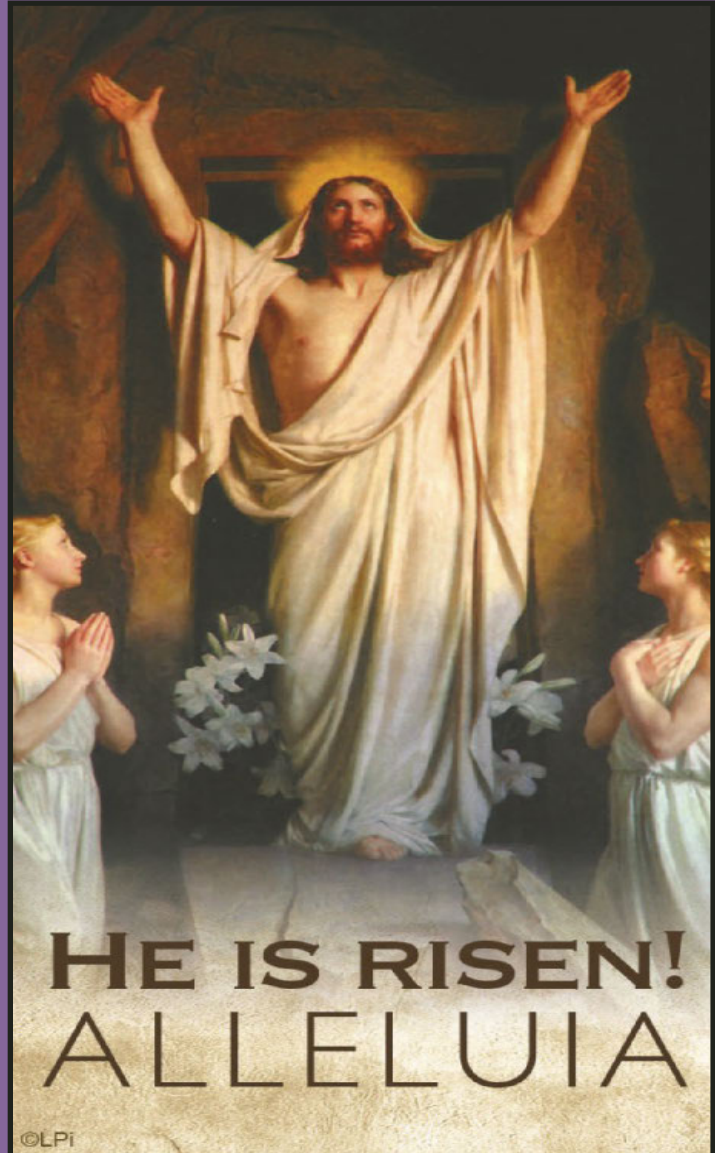

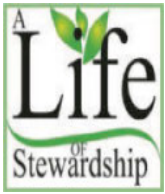

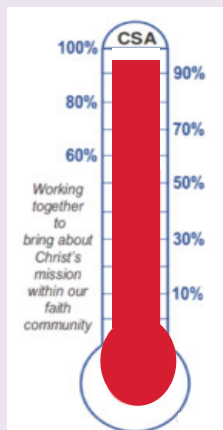

The Labouré Society

"There are very few people who realize what God would make of them if they abandoned themselves into his hands, and let themselves be formed by his grace."

The Labouré Society is a Catholic non-profit that helps aspirants to answer God's call. Every aspiring priest, sister, and brother is in serious discernment with a diocese or community and is required to work to liquidate his/her assets in order to make his/her own maximum loan payments. Through Labouré, aspirants work together as a class, raising donations which will be divided amongst the class and ultimately applied to our remaining student loans.

Why is Labouré Needed?

- The average amount of educational loans blocking aspirants in Labouré from answering God's call.
- Many religious communities cannot afford to assume their aspirants' loan debts.
- Most dioceses will allow some debt but will have a limited threshold for acceptance.
- Labouré is supported by 80+ bishops and 300+ religious institutions to help deliver their aspirants debt-free.

A Vocation Story...

"My name is Tess Austin. I am called to dedicate myself to evangelizing young people through reason, religion, and loving kindness as a sister with the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians—Salesian Sisters of St. John Bosco. I am an aspirant of Labouré and a fundraiser for a class of aspiring priests, sisters, and brothers. Many discerners are blocked from entering seminary or religious communities due to student loan debt. It is the only thing that prevents them from formation to become a priest, sister, or brother. 2. Assist by participating in efforts to strengthen community support for families.

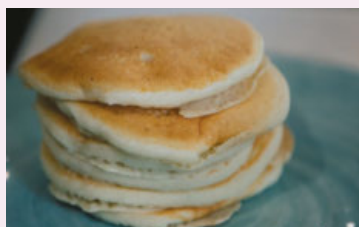

Coming in April: "Sharing Christ"

Following on the success and enthusiasm of *Discovering Christ* and *Following Christ*, Holy Family will host the third experience within the ChristLife three-step evangelization process, *Sharing Christ*, beginning Monday, April 21. *Sharing Christ* is a six-week course to train Catholics who have completed *Discovering Christ* and *Following Christ* how to share Jesus with others and invite them to become members of the Church. The course focuses on personal or friendship evangelization, how we share our relationship with Jesus with people in our day-to-day encounters. But more than that, the goal is to develop an attitude of heart that moves us to be open to share the Good News we have experienced anytime and anywhere.

The *Sharing Christ* course is the third course in the three-curriculum series of ChristLife. *Sharing Christ* is **open to all** yet is best suited for those who have completed *Discovering Christ* and *Following Christ*, as it builds upon what participants learned and experienced in those first two courses. Holy Family is hosting *Discovering Christ* again in fall, 2025. View the *Discovering Christ* page on the parish website for more information.

Sharing Christ is spread over six weekly sessions and concludes with a Saturday day retreat. After the talks, you can share your thoughts in a small group (and talk as much or as little as you wish). It's all done in a warm, friendly, and judgment-free environment. The course will run on six Monday evenings, 5:30 - 7:50 PM, April 21 through June 2 with light snacks / desserts included. (No session on Memorial Day Monday, May 26.) The Retreat Day is Saturday, June 7. There is no cost to participate in *Sharing Christ*.

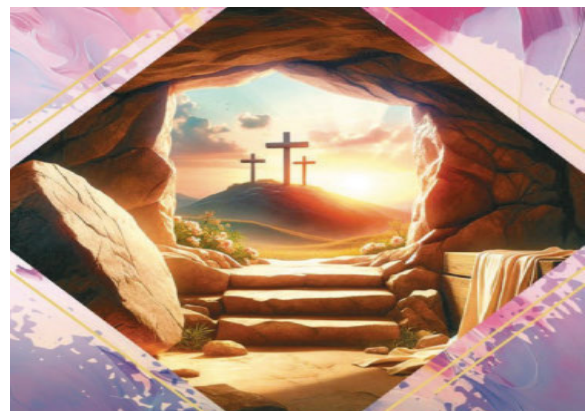

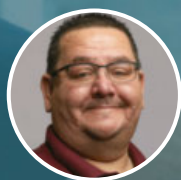
