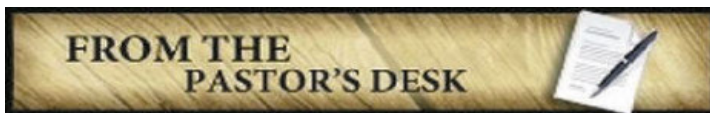

Sunday of the Word of God. 1-23-22

This Sunday we celebrate the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time, recently re-named by Pope Francis as “Sunday of the Word of God.” In the first reading, Ezra the priest-scribe proclaims the Word of God *“from daybreak till midday, in the presence of the men, the women, and those children old enough to understand. . .”* And Nehemiah, “His Excellency,” proclaims the Sabbath as a time for joy and not sorrow, of feasting and not fasting, and he tells the Jews that *“rejoicing in the LORD must be your strength.”*

The gospel this Sunday, taken from the Gospel of Luke, first shows why Luke is writing his gospel and, secondly, describes Jesus at a synagogue Liturgy of the Word service in Nazareth. Luke is writing his gospel to give Theophilus, (“Lover of God”), an accurate rendering of Jesus’ public ministry, his passion, death and resurrection. He does this so Theophilus *“may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received.”*

In chapter 4, Jesus proclaims a passage from the Book of Isaiah which describes the “anointed one” healing the sick, restoring sight to the blind, freedom to the oppressed, liberty to captives and good news to the poor. Then, Jesus simply states, *“Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.”* Next week, we will hear how his townspeople take his message and him.

All this to say, the Word of God and preaching “comforts the afflicted and afflicts the comfortable.” Biblical preaching will always challenge idolatry and insults to human dignity, especially towards the weak and vulnerable. Hence, Dr. Martin Luther King’s message and movement was met with gladness by the oppressed and the poor and with hostility by racist governors and others in power. Hence, the dignity of the unborn is met with gladness by those who want to protect and nurture life in the womb and hostility by those providers, politicians, and others who deny the humanity of the fetus.

The week of January 18-25 is also Christian Unity Week, celebrated by Catholics, Protestants and Orthodox Christians who all revere the Word of God. While it is a tragedy that there is such disunity in the Body of Christ, Vatican Council II (1962-65) strived to emphasize that we Christians all honor, teach and follow the inspired Word of God in the Bible. We continue to pray for unity in the Body of Christ, the Church.

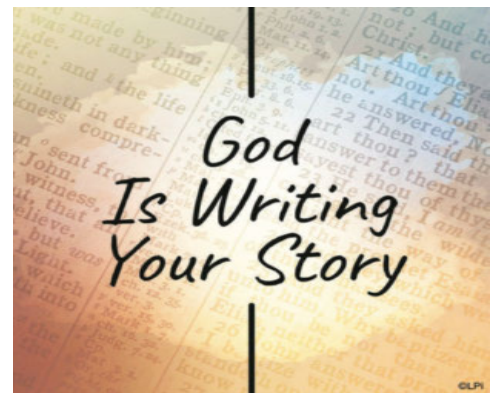
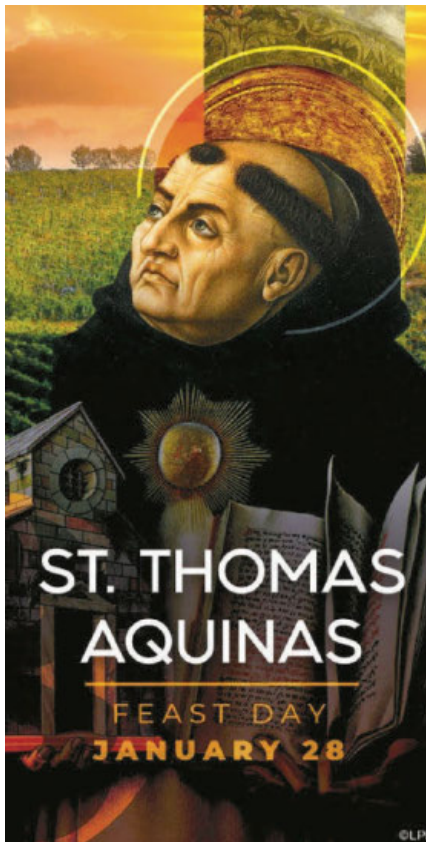

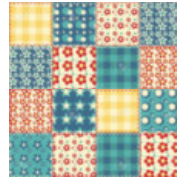
SH SCHOOL DINNER AUCTION

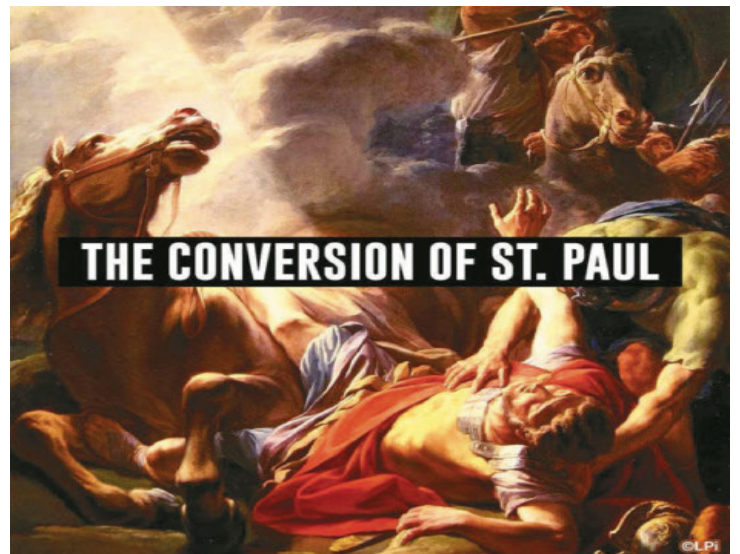
