# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time, 1-30-22

Dear Sacred Heart Parishioners,

Peace be with you! This Sunday we see and hear how people responded to Jesus' revelation of being the Messiah and his Mission Statement. Some were positively affected and marveled at his speech and works. Others were highly skeptical and openly questioned, "Who does he think he is?"

Jesus was exercising his prophetic ministry by calling his fellow believers and relatives in Nazareth to a change of heart regarding how they received Jesus and his message. He reminded them of how ancient Israel could not accept the fact that Elijah was sent to a pagan, a widow in Zarephath, to relieve the famine or how the healing of Naaman, the Syrian general and leper, another foreigner, upset Jews who wanted to see their enemies punished, not healed.

Change is hard for everyone, especially as we age. This past week, on January 25, Archbishop Rozanski formally announced "All Things New." It is the strategic planning process that has evangelization as its core value and the Archbishop is calling on all of us to be open to a process that will make us better stewards of our physical, financial and human resources.

He cites three goals in his letter: (1) unceasing prayer; (2) defining and implementing a unifying vision: (3) ensuring intentional stewardship of the gifts that God has given to the St. Louis Catholic Church over the last 200 years. He is asking for our cooperation in this process by filling out the "Disciple Maker Index" on March 2, Ash Wednesday. As we begin this historical planning process and the implementation of it, let's begin by starting with open minds and open heart.

Archbishop Rozanski announced "All Things New" on Tuesday, Jan. 25, the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. He is calling all Catholics in the Archdiocese to ongoing conversion as we begin this historic process. Let's resist the urgency to demand to know what the plan is going to look like before even starting. Let's enter into it with a prayerful, willing, and diligent spirit.
