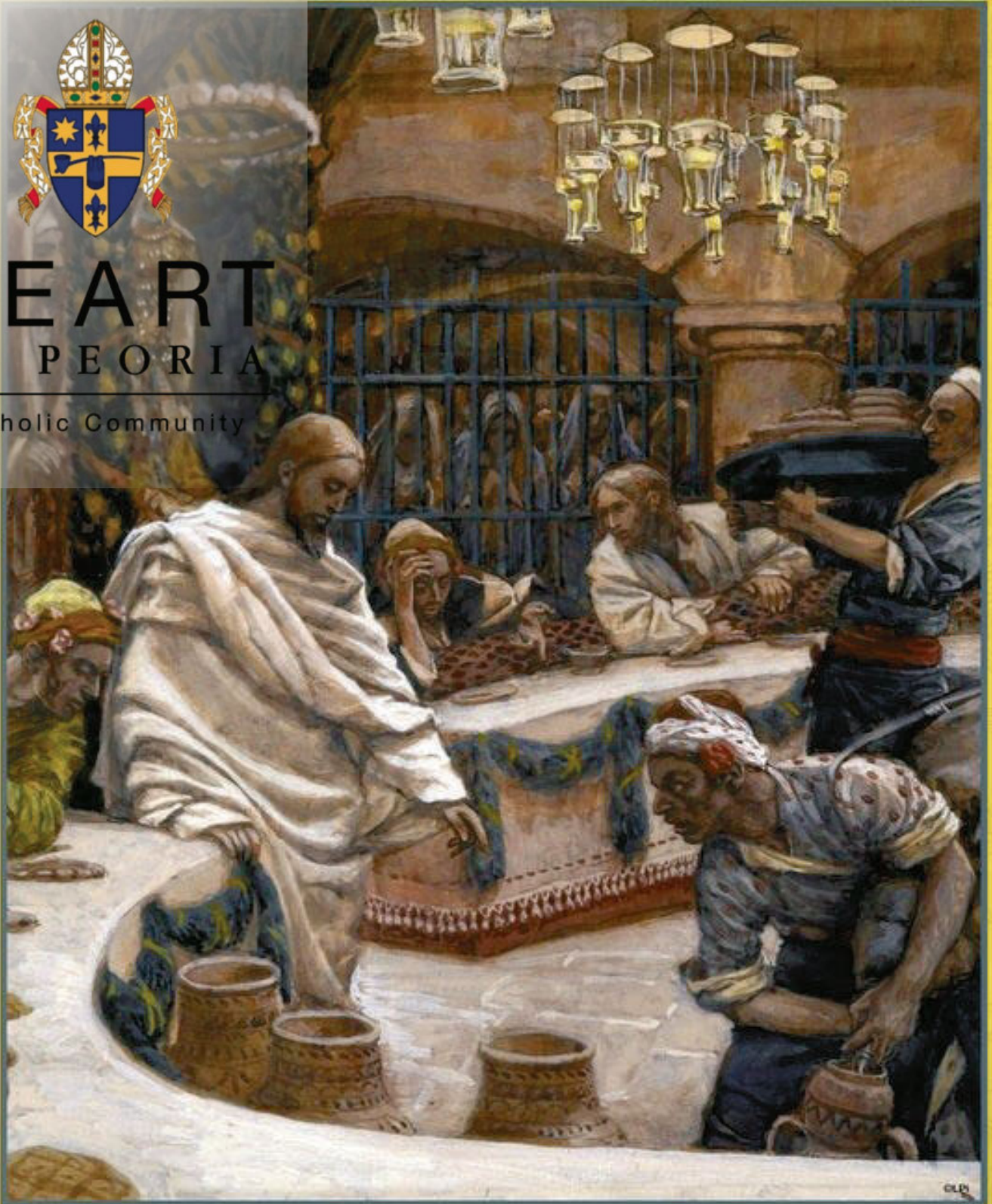

ARE YOU A REGISTERED MEMBER OF YOUR PARISH?

If you receive church contribution envelopes in the mail, you are a registered member of a parish. Your contributions are then entered into the parish computer system, and you will be able to receive an end of the year report on your contributions. If you are registered and put loose checks in the basket, they are also entered into your account in the computer. **(Using your assigned envelopes are preferred)**. If you give just once a month, you may use just one envelope instead of using each week's envelope.

If you are not receiving envelopes and want to become a registered parishioner, you will need to fill out a "new parishioner" form. Please call the parish office and one will be mailed to you, or look for a form at the doors of our churches. You can put it in the collection basket, drop at the church office, or in the mail.

You may use your envelopes at any church, as they are sent to the church indicated when money is counted.

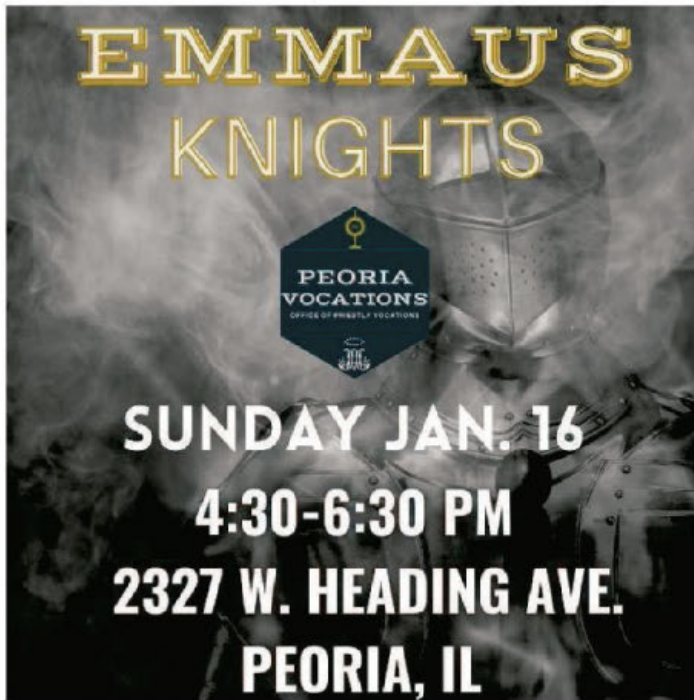

St. Sebastian | January 20

Not much is known about the life of St. Sebastian (256 – 287), except that he was a Roman martyr whose name has been mentioned throughout history since early 350.

We see St. Sebastian many times in art, especially from iconic paintings from Guido Reni, Andrea Mantegna and Hendrick ter Brugghen. Historical scholars now agree that a spiritual story has the beloved saint entering the Roman army because only there could he assist Christian martyrs without arousing suspicion on himself. Eventually he was found out, brought before Emperor Diocletian and delivered to Mauritanian archers to be shot to death. Pierced with arrows, he was left for dead, but managed to survive. He recovered from his wounds but still refused to leave.

One day, St. Sebastian took up a position near where the emperor was to pass. He confronted the emperor, condemning him for his cruelty to Christians. This time the sentence of death was carried out, and St. Sebastian was beaten to death with clubs. Today he is the patron saint of athletes.

It Takes All Kinds

“If every flower wanted to be a rose,” wrote St. Therese of Lisieux, “spring would lose its loveliness.”

Who is God asking you to be today? There is an obvious answer that springs to mind right out of the gate. God wants me to be a good person (a good father, a good husband) today; today, God wants me to be a saint.

But this answer fails to get to the heart of the question. We are all striving today to serve the same Spirit, but we are given different gifts to do so. The one who has the gift of knowledge may fail if today he decides he wants to be a healer. The one who has the gift of “varieties of tongues” might falter in the expression of wisdom.

Think about the wedding at Cana and the players in the scene: the servers, the guests, the bride and groom. They all have a unique role to play, and though it is to the servers that Mary gives the instruction, “Do whatever he tells you,” her words apply to all.

Today, are we called to be the servers — do we wait on God’s instruction and carry it out, no matter how foolish or impossible it may seem to our human ears? Are we asked to be the disciples, to bear witness to a miracle and to give our testimony? Are we called to imitate the Blessed Mother herself and give encouragement to follow God’s word?

Let us examine our gifts and listen in the silence of our hearts to the direction of the Spirit. Then and only then, let us do whatever He tells us.

“Hagan lo que él les diga”.

Santa María, que percibe la falta de vino en una boda en Caná, ve también lo que nos hace falta en nuestras vidas, sabe de las virtudes que necesitamos para asemejarnos cada vez más a su Hijo, el Señor Jesús: más fe, más caridad, más esperanza, más paciencia, más alegría, más pureza, más humildad. Ayer como hoy, Ella intercede también ante su Hijo para que transforme el agua de nuestra insuficiencia o mediocridad en el “vino nuevo” de una vida santa, plena de caridad, rebosante de alegría.

Al aspirar a conformarnos con el Señor Jesús, el Hijo de Santa María, hemos de tener muy presente que sólo Él puede ayudarnos a cambiar nuestros vicios por virtudes. Así como Jesús transformó el agua en vino, Él puede también transformar nuestros corazones endurecidos por nuestros pecados y opciones contra Dios en corazones “de carne”, capaces de amar como Él nos ha amado (ver Ez 36,26-27).

Para que se dé esta transformación interior en nuestras vidas Santa María intercede incesantemente por cada uno de nosotros, sus hijos e hijas, ante el Señor, al tiempo que nos urge a nosotros: «¡hagan lo que Él les diga!» (Jn 2,5). Si bien el Señor realiza el milagro de la transformación del agua en vino gracias a la intercesión de su Madre, lo hace también en la medida en que los siervos cooperan haciendo lo que Él les indica, obedeciendo a su palabra. Del mismo modo, el Señor obrará nuestra conversión y santificación sólo en la medida en que prestemos nuestra decidida cooperación desde el recto ejercicio de nuestra propia libertad. Si cooperamos con el Señor cada día, obedeciéndole, procurando poner por obra lo que Él nos dice, Él realizará en nosotros por el don de su Espíritu el milagro de nuestra progresiva santificación, hasta que podamos también nosotros afirmar como el Apóstol Pablo: «vivo yo, más no yo, sino que es Cristo quien vive en mí» (Gál 2,20).

¿Pero cómo me habla el Señor, de modo que pueda “hacer lo que Él me diga”, cada vez que descubra que me “falta el vino” de alguna virtud? Cuando te falte fe, escucha al Señor que te dice: «No se turbe tu corazón. Crees en Dios: cree también en mí» (Jn 14,1); si te falta la esperanza y resistencia en las tribulaciones, Él te dice: «¡ánimo!: yo he vencido al mundo» (Jn 16,33); si te falta caridad: «ámense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado» (Jn 15,12); si te falta la humildad, y pretendes dar frutos de santidad por ti mismo, Él te dice: «El que permanece en mí y yo en él, ése da mucho fruto; porque separados de mí no pueden hacer nada» (Jn 15,5); si te falta paciencia: «aprende de mí que soy manso y humilde de corazón»; si te falta capacidad de perdón y consientes resentimientos, rencores, deseos de venganza, Él te dice: perdona «hasta setenta veces siete» (Mt 18,22); si te falta generosidad, te dice: «A todo el que te pida, da» (Lc 6,30); si te falta la perseverancia en la oración, Él te dice: «es preciso orar siempre sin desfallecer» (Lc 18,1). Ante todo lo que nos hace falta, acudamos al Señor y escuchemos reverentes aquellas enseñanzas a las que María nos invita a adherirnos de mente, corazón y acción: ***«¡hagan lo que Él les diga!» (Dies Domini).***

Domingo 16 de enero. II durante el año. Jn 2, 1-11

En aquel tiempo, hubo una boda en Caná de Galilea, a la cual asistió la madre de Jesús. Éste y sus discípulos también fueron invitados. Como llegara a faltar el vino, María le dijo a Jesús: “Ya no tienen vino”. Jesús le contestó: “Mujer, ¿qué podemos hacer tú y yo? Todavía no llega mi hora”. Pero ella dijo a los que servían: ***“Hagan lo que él les diga”.*** Había allí seis tinajas de piedra, de unos cien litros cada una, que servían para las purificaciones de los judíos. Jesús dijo a los que servían: “Llenen de agua esas tinajas”. Y las llenaron hasta el borde. Entonces les dijo: “Saquen ahora un poco y llévenselo al mayordomo”. Así lo hicieron, y en cuanto el mayordomo probó el agua convertida en vino, sin saber su procedencia, porque sólo los sirvientes la sabían, llamó al novio y le dijo: “Todo el mundo sirve primero el vino mejor, y cuando los invitados ya han bebido bastante, se sirve el corriente. Tú, en cambio, has guardado el vino mejor hasta ahora”. Esto que hizo Jesús en Caná de Galilea fue el primero de sus signos. Así manifestó su gloria y sus discípulos creyeron en él.

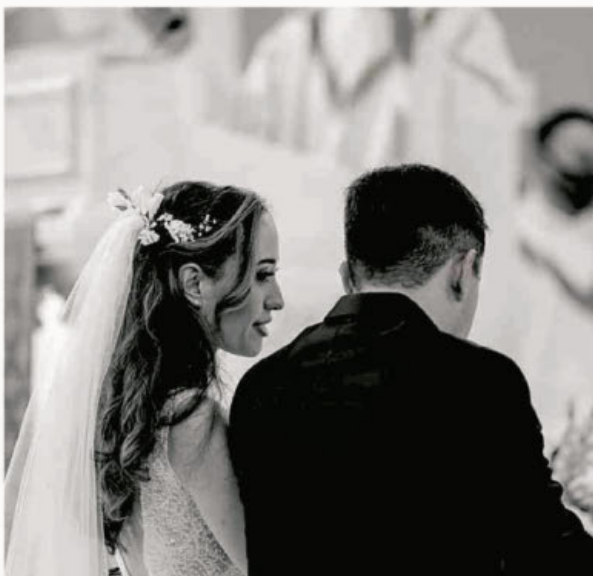
La palabra episcopado indica, por un lado, el oficio episcopal como sacramento y, por otro, el colegio constituido por los obispos de la Iglesia universal. El colegio episcopal es la continuación del colegio de los apóstoles, pues los obispos ejercen el ministerio magisterial, pastoral y sacerdotal de los apóstoles por el poder del Espíritu Santo (LG 22).

El episcopado es un ministerio que ha sido constituido, para siempre, por Dios en la Iglesia (LG 18). Los obispos, "puestos por el Espíritu Santo" (Hch 20,28), presiden en nombre de Dios el rebaño de Cristo (LG 20).

En la ordenación sacramental, el Espíritu hace que "los obispos, de manera eminente y visible, hagan las veces del mismo Cristo, Maestro, Pastor y Sacerdote, y actúen en su persona" (LG 21). En el ejercicio de su ministerio son "vicarios y legados de Cristo" (LG 27).

En su Iglesia local, el obispo es "el principio y fundamento visible de la unidad" (LG 23), es decir, de la comunión de los presbíteros, diáconos y demás ministerios eclesiales. El episcopado único no absorbe la multiplicidad de las misiones y los ministerios. Los fieles deben adherir a la decisión que, sobre una materia de fe y costumbres, ha tomado su obispo en nombre de Cristo y aceptarla con espíritu de obediencia religiosa (LG 25).

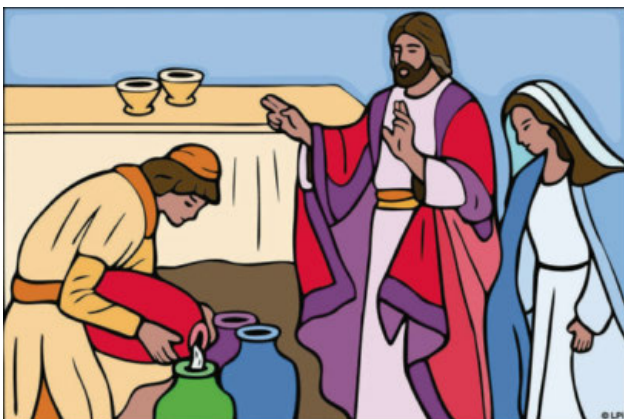
