

Today's Gospel: Mt 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, “Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage.”……. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

Reflection: Epiphany of The Lord

Today's Gospel teaches us how Christ enriches those who bring Him their hearts and offer their lives to Him. The adoration of the Magi fulfills the oracle of Isaiah (first reading), prophesying that the nations of the world would travel to the Holy City following a brilliant light, bringing gold and incense to contribute to the worship of God. Today's Responsorial Psalm (Ps 72) verses 10-11 picture kings from foreign lands bringing gifts to pay homage to a just king in Israel. Paul's letter to the Church of Ephesus (today's second reading), expresses God's secret plan in clear terms: “*the Gentiles are...co-heirs ... co-partners in the promise, in Christ Jesus through the Gospel.*” Today's Gospel reminds us that if God brought the Magi – foreigners and pagans – to recognize and give Jesus proper respect as the King of Jews, we should know that there is nothing in our sinful lives that would keep God from bringing us to Jesus. There were three groups of people who reacted to the Epiphany of Christ's birth. The first group, headed by King Herod, tried to eliminate Jesus, the second group, priests and scribes, ignored Jesus, and the third group, represented by the shepherds and the Magi, came to adore Jesus.

(1) Let us make sure that we belong to the third group:

a) by actively worshiping Jesus at Mass with the gold of our love, the myrrh of our humility and the frankincense of our adoration;

b) by giving a new direction to our lives. Just as the Magi chose another route to return to their homes, let us choose a better way of life, abstaining from proud, unjust and impure thoughts, words, and actions, evil habits, and selfish behavior;

c) by becoming stars leading others to Jesus, as the star led the Magi to Jesus. Let us remove the darkness of the evil around us by radiating the light of Jesus' love through selfless service, unconditional forgiveness and compassionate care.

(2) Like the Magi, let us offer Jesus our gifts on this feast of Epiphany and every day:

(a) the Gift of our life by offering it on the altar during the Holy Mass and every morning as soon as we get up, asking for the strengthening anointing of the Holy Spirit to do good and avoid evil during the course of the day.

b) the Gift of responsive relationship with God by talking to Him in personal and family prayers and listening to Him through reading the Holy Bible every day.

c) the Gift of friendship with God by recognizing Jesus' presence in, and offering loving, humble service to, everyone we encounter, and by getting reconciled to God every night asking His pardon and forgiveness for our sins and failures during the day.

El Evangelio: Mt 2, 1-12

Jesús nació en Belén de Judá, en tiempos del rey Herodes. Unos magos de oriente llegaron entonces a Jerusalén y preguntaron: “¿Dónde está el rey de los judíos que acaba de nacer? Porque vimos surgir su estrella y hemos venido a adorarlo”.

Al enterarse de esto, el rey Herodes se sobresaltó y toda Jerusalén con él. Convocó entonces a los sumos sacerdotes y a los escribas del pueblo y les preguntó dónde tenía que nacer el Mesías. Ellos le contestaron: “En Belén de Judá, porque así lo ha escrito el profeta: Y tú, Belén, tierra de Judá, no eres en manera alguna la menor entre las ciudades ilustres de Judá, pues de ti saldrá un jefe, que será el pastor de mi pueblo, Israel”.

Entonces Herodes llamó en secreto a los magos, para que le precisaran el tiempo en que se les había aparecido la estrella y los mandó a Belén, diciéndoles: “Vayan a averiguar cuidadosamente qué hay de ese niño y, cuando lo encuentren, avísenme para que yo también vaya a adorarlo”.

Después de oír al rey, los magos se pusieron en camino, y de pronto la estrella que habían visto surgir, comenzó a guiarlos, hasta que se detuvo encima de donde estaba el niño. Al ver de nuevo la estrella, se llenaron de inmensa alegría. Entraron en la casa y vieron al niño con María, su madre, y postrándose, lo adoraron. Después, abriendo sus cofres, le ofrecieron regalos: oro, incienso y mirra. Advertidos durante el sueño de que no volvieran a Herodes, regresaron a su tierra por otro camino.

Reflexión: Epifanía del Señor

El evangelio de hoy nos enseña cómo Cristo enriquece a quienes le llevan el corazón y le ofrecen la vida. La adoración de los Magos cumple el oráculo de Isaías (primera lectura), profetizando que las naciones del mundo viajarían a la Ciudad Santa siguiendo una luz brillante, trayendo oro e incienso para contribuir al culto de Dios. El Salmo Responsorial de hoy (Sal 72), versículos 10-11, describe a reyes de tierras extranjeras trayendo regalos para rendir homenaje a un rey justo en Israel. La carta de Pablo a la Iglesia de Éfeso (segunda lectura de hoy) expresa el plan secreto de Dios en términos claros: "los gentiles son ... coherederos ... co-socios en la promesa, en Cristo Jesús a través del Evangelio". El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que si Dios trajo a los magos, extranjeros y paganos, a reconocer y respetar a Jesús como el Rey de los judíos, deberíamos saber que no hay nada en nuestras vidas pecaminosas que impida que Dios nos lleve a Jesús. Hubo tres grupos de personas que reaccionaron a la Epifanía del nacimiento de Cristo. El primer grupo, encabezado por el rey Herodes, trató de eliminar a Jesús, el segundo grupo, sacerdotes y escribas, ignoró a Jesús, y el tercer grupo, representado por los pastores y los magos, llegó a adorar a Jesús.

(1) Asegurémonos de pertenecer al tercer grupo:

- a) adorando activamente a Jesús en la Misa con el oro de nuestro amor, la mirra de nuestra humildad y el incienso de nuestra adoración;
- b) dando un nuevo rumbo a nuestra vida. Así como los magos eligieron otro camino para regresar a sus hogares, escojamos una mejor forma de vida, absteniéndonos de pensamientos, palabras y acciones orgullosos, injustos e impuros, malos hábitos y comportamientos egoístas;
- c) convirtiéndose en estrellas que llevan a otros a Jesús, como la estrella llevó a los Magos a Jesús. Eliminemos la oscuridad del mal que nos rodea irradiando la luz del amor de Jesús a través del servicio desinteresado, el perdón incondicional y el cuidado compasivo.

(2) Como los magos, ofrezcamos a Jesús nuestros dones en esta fiesta de la Epifanía y todos los días:

- (a) el Don de nuestra vida ofreciéndolo en el altar durante la Santa Misa y cada mañana tan pronto como nos levantamos, pidiendo la unción fortalecedora del Espíritu Santo para hacer el bien y evitar el mal durante el transcurso del día.
- b) el Don de una relación receptiva con Dios hablando con Él en oraciones personales y familiares y escuchándolo a través de la lectura de la Santa Biblia todos los días.
