#### **SHJ FAITH FORMATION**

### Lecito Devinia

**Lectio Divina** is divine reading. We are encouraged to read Scripture by going over one particular passage slowly, rereading it, pondering it and seeing if anything in particular touches our spirit.

One of my favorite spiritual writers is Frederick Buechner, recommended by Mr. Rogers himself. And one of my favorite pieces of his is "The **Birth"** which can be found in **Magnificent Defeat**, a book of essays on the Christian life, the miracles of grace and the mystery of Christmas and Easter.

Buechner's *Lectio Divina* for the Nativity story brought him to wonder what, if anything, the lesser characters remembered about that night or how it impacted their life. The innkeeper, the Magi and a shepherd speak as if they are responding to questions from Buechner. The innkeeper talks defensively yet honestly, responding to the stories of no room at the inn. The Magi speak of tricking Herod and of the feeling deep within that they didn't understand yet knew that they had to make the trip. Finally the shepherd speaks of a long, cold and hungry night that comes alive and you see what you've been looking at forever and had missed.

Each story, each character, has a message for us – one they learned after reflecting on that night for many years. Buechner tells the story beautifully, from a different perspective than we are used to. "The Birth" gave me, and I hope you as well, points of the story to reflect more deeply on.
