Lumen Christi is proud to announce that parishioner and 1st grade teacher, Kimberly Paulson, has been nominated for The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's Man & Woman of the Year 2022. This is a cause near and dear to Kimberly's heart, as her daughter Emma Rose is a two-time leukemia survivor.

Many of you will remember Emma Rose's story, as her name was on our prayer request list for a long time. At 16, Emma Rose was diagnosed with leukemia. She endured 2.5 years of nightmarish treatment. At 21, she was told that it had come back. Greater heartache, harsher treatment, and Bone Marrow Transplant using her brother Steven's marrow saved Emma's life a second time.

Throughout Emma's years of treatment, the Paulson's were active in the cancer community, helping other families dealing with the cancer diagnosis and treatment. Emma started an organization "Patient Helping Patients" to give comfort items to other children in the hospital going through treatment. Kim is honored to have been given the opportunity to help others through The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) Man & Woman of the Year campaign.

"I witnessed first-hand the devastating effects that blood cancers have on patients and their families. I will always fight for my daughter, for the families of the children I have met and grown close to, for my friends who lost their children, and for the 46 children who will be diagnosed today, and every day. This is why I am so inspired to support LLS's monumental efforts."



The Man & Woman of the Year campaign is a 10 week philanthropic competition for leaders in local communities across the US. Kim is competing against three other women in the Milwaukee area.

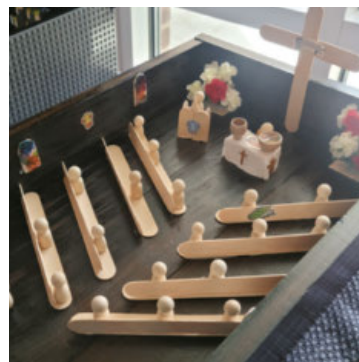
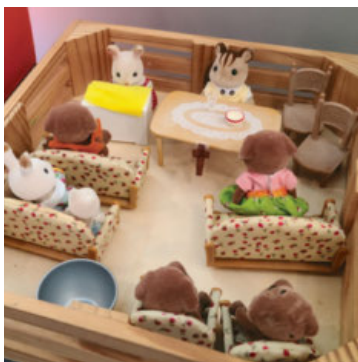
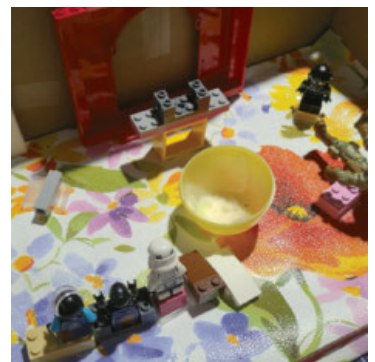

Qualified candidates may be nominated by submitting a written nomination signed by 10 or more registered, confirmed, and practicing parishioners, to Fr. Matthew. All written nominations must be presented to Fr. Matthew at the parish office by June 5, 2022. If there are no nominations, the pastor will designate the Trustee - Secretary with a new term starting July 1, 2022.

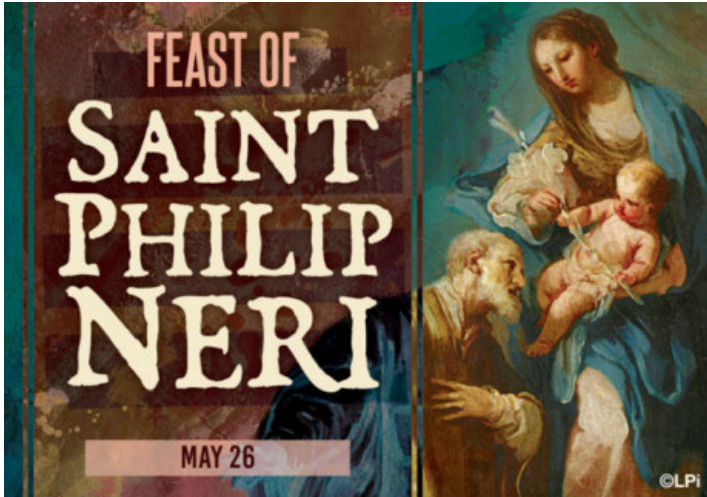

Creation Care Corner

"To defend the earth and to safeguard water is to protect life." - Pope Francis

WEEKLY RECOMMENDATION

Reduce outdoor watering waste.

Experts estimate that 50 percent of the water we use outdoors goes to waste from evaporation, wind, or runoff due to overwatering. Frequent lawn watering is expensive and often unnecessary. A typical lawn only needs about one inch of water per week to survive. So if there is no rain, water every 6-8 days to reduce your water bill. A best practice: water for 15 minutes then allow the water to soak in for a while and repeat 3-4 times, lessening waste of water runoff. This deeper soaking technique encourages the roots to grow deeper and be more drought resistant. Water early in the morning or at sunset to reduce loss from evaporation. Check the spigots for leaks.



CUB SCOUT EARTH DAY PROJECT

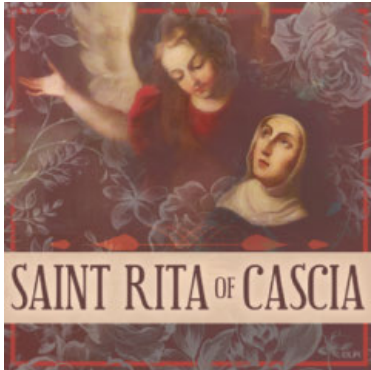

SAINT OF THE WEEK – ST. RITA OF CASCIA | MAY 22

St. Rita of Cascia (1381 – 1457) had the opportunity to live her life as a wife, mother, widow, and eventually, member of a religious community. Born in central Italy, St. Rita felt the calling to become a nun, but was pressured at a young age into marriage. During her 18-year marriage to a cruel man, she raised two sons. When her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons died, St. Rita decided to go back to her first love and attempted to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. Her status as a widow caused some complications to her entering, but she eventually succeeded in professing vows. Throughout her lifetime, St. Rita of Cascia was known for her prayerfulness and charity. She also experienced stigmata on her forehead, meditated frequently on Christ's passion, and cared for the nuns of her religious community and those in the lay community who came to her for counsel. ©LPI

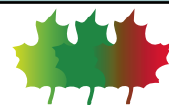
