





They must be Catholics who are registered, confirmed, practicing members of the parish and at least 25 years of age. The position of Trustee - Secretary becomes available this year. Correction from last week: John Clark will be stepping back as Trustee after 10 years of service to the parish. Thank you for your service, John! Qualified candidates may be nominated by submitting a written nomination signed by 10 or more registered, confirmed, and practicing parishioners, to Fr. Matthew. All written nominations must be presented to Fr. Matthew at the parish office by June 5, 2022. If there are no nominations, the pastor will designate the Trustee - Secretary with a new term starting July 1, 2022.

Local, Organic. Food travels an average of 1,200 miles before it reaches your plate, so buying locally grown can save energy and prevent air pollution. Also, fresh foods require significantly less energy than frozen foods (but watch out for spoilage which contributes to food waste!). Organics benefit the environment by not relying on synthetic pesticides or fertilizers which can contaminate soil and water. Other benefits of fresh, local and organic can be healthier foods with better taste. Farmers markets and Community Supported Agriculture (CSAs) are both great ways to support a local food system.

MISSIONARY FRATERNITY OF MARY UPDATES NEWSLETTER SPRING ISSUE 2022

In response to the needs of the people of God, on March 12, 2022, a new mission area was entrusted to the Missionary Fraternity of Mary at San Esteban Parish (St. Stephen) in the Diocese of Trujillo, located in the Trujillo City, province of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Central America. The Trujillo Diocese cover 15,718 miles square in the districts of Colón, northeast of Honduras. 53% of the population in this area are Catholics and 47% evangelicals. Due to lack of clergy in the diocese, Rt. Rev. Luis Felipe Solé Fa, C.M. (Bishop of Trujillo), requested the presence of Fraternity priests to take care of the spiritual and pastoral guidance for the Catholic faithful in Balfate, Trujillo. The Fraternity expresses our words of thanks to Bishop Luis Felipe Sole Fa and the Parishioners of San Esteban Parish for their warm welcome in the Trujillo Diocese. Additionally, due to the relationship that started with then St. James Parish, and now Lumen Christi, two more MFOM priests will be serving in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee bringing the total to eight priests.

Other News

Venezuela: The presence of the Fraternity continues to be strong in these challenging missions. Please pray for the perseverance of our priests in this country.

Guatemala: On February 19th, five seminarians were ordained Deacons at the Metropolitan Cathedral of Guatemala, Guatemala City.




