THANK YOU LETTER FROM ST. HYACINTH

Dear Lumen Christi Community,

We the St. Hyacinth Community are blessed to have you as a sister parish. Your generous support has helped raise part of the replacement cost of St. Hyacinth's ailing roof. This will help ensure the continuity of our historic building which has served the south side since 1883.

Through our gathering together to socialize and pray, we have been able to have cultural exchanges while united under the banners of the Holy Roman Church and the American flag. For as the fathers of the Second Vatican Council wrote in 1964:

It follows that though there are many nations there is but one people of God, which takes its citizens from every race, making them citizens of a kingdom which is of a heavenly rather than of an earthly nature. All the faithful, scattered though they be throughout the world, are in communion with each other in the Holy Spirit, and so, 'he who dwells in Rome knows that the people of India are his members.' . . . [The Church] fosters and takes to itself, insofar as they are good, the ability, riches, and customs in which the genius of each people expresses itself. (*Lumen Gentium* II.13)

And as we together honor how the Poles beautifully expressed their unique culture and faith in the construction of the St. Hyacinth Church, many of whom were the ancestors of Lumen Christi parishioners, so too have we come together as Catholics, those primarily native to the United States and those from Latin America, sharing our riches and customs. Thanks to you, we of the St. Hyacinth Congregation are greatly aided in maintaining a vibrant Catholic parish for years to come.

We hope to continue sharing our expressions of the faith well into the future. We cordially invite you to see the new roof upon completion. We can celebrate mass and revel in the Polish architectural and artistic legacy imbued in the St. Hyacinth Church which has been handed down to us Latinos.

Keeping you in our daily prayers, we ask God's generous blessings of peace, happiness, and good health on you and your parish.

Each year, the Church recalls with a liturgical feast the marvelous gift of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist. The Solemnity of Corpus Christi (June 19th this year), coming after the birth of the Church at Pentecost and the worship of the Trinity, reminds us that the Eucharist is our greatest treasure on this earth and the source and summit of our Catholic faith.

As the Church in the United States begins a three-year Eucharist Revival this June, we echo their 'call and challenge for every Catholic across the United States to rekindle the fire of love and devotion for the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus.' CREATION CARE CORNER RECOMMENDATION

"... to defend the earth and to safeguard water is to protect life." — Pope Francis



Plastic waste is a huge and growing problem. Only 9% of the 9 billion tons of plastic produced has been recycled. There is very little demand for the plastic you do recycle. 40% of all plastic is designed to be used once and tossed. Plastic doesn't decompose easily and can last 100s of years. The waste clogs landfills and waterways, and poses hazards to animals and fish life. It breaks up into ever smaller microplastics getting into our air and food chain with unknown health effects.

What you can do:

- Say NO to single-use plastic. Carry your own cups, bags, to-go containers, utensils and forget the straws.
- Say NO to bottled water and pop. Carry refillables.
- Choose more biodegradable/recyclable materials like glass, paper, cardboard and metal instead of plastic... and then recycle those items.
- Avoid products with excessive packaging, excessive plastic packaging, and parts. If it leaves behind plastic trash, try not to buy it.

Recycle what you can't refuse, reduce or reuse.

DO YOU SPEAK STEWARDSHIP?

If you are married, I'm guessing that you know the best way to break bad news to your spouse, whether you realize it or not. Maybe it's simply that you know not to talk about the budget after your wife's football team has lost. Maybe you know your husband will take the news that your sister is coming to stay a little easier if you tell him over his favorite dinner. We do the same thing with our children, our friends, our coworkers — we have all learned the language of the people we love.

The truth is the same in every language, but it's important for us to convey that truth graciously. That's what Pentecost teaches us. The gift of being able to speak in tongues afforded the Apostles a practical skill to spread the Gospel message, but it also served as a powerful symbol of the importance of effective communication. Evangelization can only happen when you're speaking in words a person is able, ready, and willing to hear.

Let's ask ourselves: what is the language we need to speak to share the truth with the person who is standing in front of us? Is it the language of quality time? The language of concern? The language of laughter and friendship? The language of authenticity, of plain talk and frankness?

The Holy Spirit gave the Apostles the ability to speak in tongues, and it seems miraculous when we read about it in the Gospels — but only consider that we all have this same ability, in a certain way. The Holy Spirit can and will show us how to speak the truth, if we only ask.
