


NEW PARISHIONER WELCOME FOLDERS AT WELCOME DESK

Minimize plastic waste. Humans buy 1,000,000 plastic bottles every minute! Plastic recycling limitations means only about 25% of plastic bottles will get recycled in the U.S. The rest

end up in waterways and landfills where they last 100s of years. The recycling rate for aluminum is much higher. Consider buying your pop in metal cans and then recycle them. Practice BYOB for water. Fill a reusable water bottle from home and bring it with you. Don't like the taste of tap water? Buy a filter and save! (Remember, much of bottled water sold today is simply filtered tap water).
