



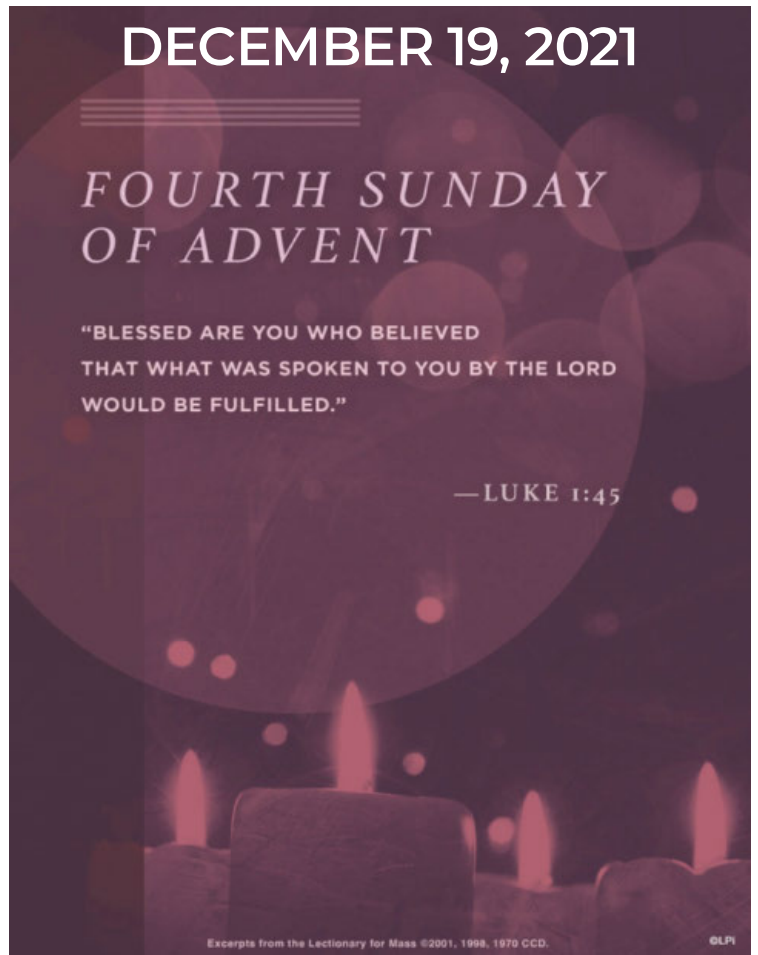

**For the 2021 tax year only, non-itemizers can deduct donations!**

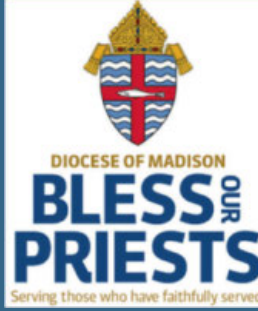
- Non-itemizers can deduct up to \$300 single or \$600 jointly. Your offertory is eligible for this deduction.


