

Faith Formation Corner

Sometimes we can get stuck in our own perspective of the world. We see the world through our own eyes and miss the perspective of our Heavenly Father. It can be hard to see this world from the perspective of the Father because of the things going on in our world, the way people treat us, the way we treat ourselves, the bad things that happen, etc. Sometimes God can just feel very far away.

How can we keep reorienting ourselves to HIS perspective instead of our own? That question can be answered if we first answer the question, how do you start and end your day? Many people might say they start their day with a hot cup of coffee, or a good breakfast. As Catholic Christians, our answer should instead be, "with God." Just as starting your body off right with a good breakfast is important, so is starting off your mind and soul right by spending time with God.

When we pray, I always find it helpful to do 2 things:

- 1. Be honest with God. If you come to Him at the end of a long work day, you feel exhausted, out of sorts, and feel frustrated, share that with Him! He knows that not everything is going to be perfect each day; He would rather hear honestly how you are doing, than not hear from you at all!
- 2. **Take time to listen.** After sharing your heart with God, let Him share His heart with you! He knows what you need, what parts of your heart need to be healed, what parts need to be encouraged, and what parts are already on fire with His love. He speaks through His Word, and through the silence.

Take some time to be with God this week and to ask for Him to show you His perspective, and His heart. You may be surprised what He tells you!




