4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.




All this offered in REPARATION for the sins of blasphemy and ingratitude committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.


tradition to our heirs. At **St. John**





February 2 is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas. Candlemas, occurs 40 days after Christmas, marking the first time Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the

temple for the rites of purification and dedication as prescribed by Jewish law. It is traditional for candles to be blessed at this Mass. Parishioners are invited to bring their own candles to the Mass on February 2 to have them blessed for use at home throughout the year. The candles can be in any style (votive, tealight, taper, etc.).



February 3 is the Feast of St. Blaise. We will offer the general blessing of throats after Communion at Masses on January 29 and 30. Individual throat blessings will be given at the weekday Masses on Wednesday February 2 and Thursday February 3. Did you know we have a relic of St. Blaise?!
