#### Faith Formation Corner

For a long time, I had faked having a relationship with Our Blessed Mother, Mary. Even after I had a relationship with Jesus, and although I have taught about our faith and Mother Mary since I was a freshman in high school, and my family has a huge devotion to our Blessed Mother my whole life, I just never really knew how to go about it. I thought for a long time as I grew up, why are we focusing so much time learning about Mary? Shouldn't our focus be only on Jesus - isn't He the most important?

So many people in my life told me about their incredible devotion to Our Lady and I just didn't get it. I thought maybe some people were called to have that special relationship with Mary, and some weren't. I figured I would just keep praying the same way I always had and if Mary wanted to make herself known to me, she would! I did a consecration to Mary for the first time my senior year of high school, promising that I would give my heart to her, and she would promise to give her heart to me, to be my mother, and I, her child. Even then, deep down, nothing really seemed to click for me - I knew it was a special moment, it was filled with a lot of peace for me, and I did really try to give my all to her, but I didn't feel like much in my life had changed after the fact.

Recently I was struggling talking with anyone about one particular wound on my heart and Holy Spirit nudged me to stop in front of a statue of Mary. I did, and I poured my heart out to her - desperately wanting to feel a mother's love and embrace and wanting someone to understand. I ranted through all my problems, and I just asked that she could hold my hand and bring me through the day. She is such a gentle person, really a truly gentle and calming mother - just the kind of person I needed to talk to. It felt too intimidating to bring it all straight to Jesus, and I thought a mother's heart could understand.

It's not a deep relationship yet, and I still wonder sometimes about how to go deeper and how to relate to her, but if I've learned anything about God and the Holy Family over the past few years, it is the fact that they don't push, they don't force themselves on you, but instead gently invite you closer to them when you are ready. God can come to us without Mary, He doesn't need anything extra to encounter and love us. But sometimes, our human hearts need help. That's where Mary comes in. Mary doesn't pick favorites. She is here for all of us as a gift from the Lord. I encourage you to persevere in your relationship with Mary, even when you feel forgotten or left out. Mary has a love and heart for you because she knows how much Jesus yearns for you. Let your mother help you, she's just waiting for you to ask. *~United in Christ, Bethany*
