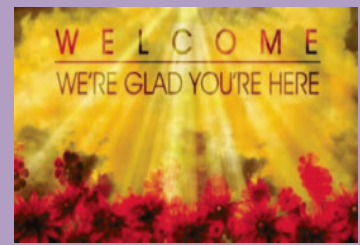

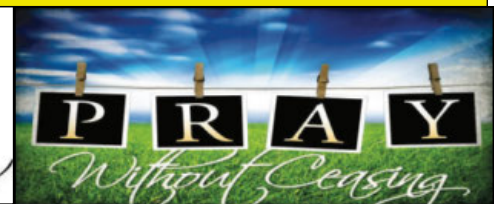

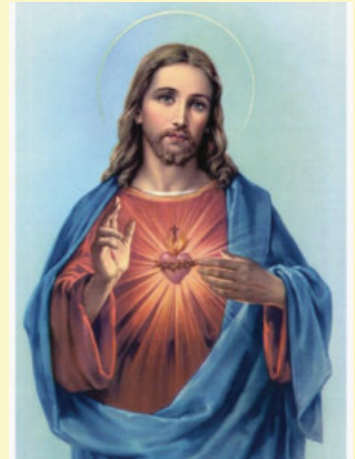

**Faith Formation Corner**

Many people have asked me if I take a break during the summer because we don't have Faith Formation classes - I usually smile, and maybe laugh a little, because summer seems to be just as busy of a time as the rest of the year, only in a different way. During the summer, we have multiple mission trips happening, a week of Totus Tuus, and this summer I have a week of training to prepare for our upcoming Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program for this fall. In addition, it is a time to look back at the last year of Faith Formation, see what worked well, see what needs adjusting, and then prepare for the start of classes in the fall!



I don't say all this to give you my to do list for the summer, but rather to help us reflect on what is most important. Whether it is summer, winter, spring or fall, we always seem to get consumed by so many things happening in our lives. All of these things may very well be good and enriching things! However, if we lose sight of WHY we do what we do, that is when we run into a very large problem.

Did you know that June is the month we dedicate to the Sacred Heart of Jesus? I remember when Fr. Paider was here, during one of his homilies, he talked about the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He told us to look at Jesus' Sacred Heart - look at the rays coming off the heart. These rays represent the passion and love Christ has for each and every one of us. Then he told us to ask ourselves, "what are we passionate about? What does Christ want us to be passionate about?"

It really got me thinking and makes me reflect on all the things I do that keep me busy, all the things I do, not only for our parishes, but also in my personal life. Are we busy being passionate about the things that matter? Are we keeping our focus on Him? Are we doing what would make Christ smile, or are we too wrapped up in trying to get it all done that we miss the point in WHY we are doing it?

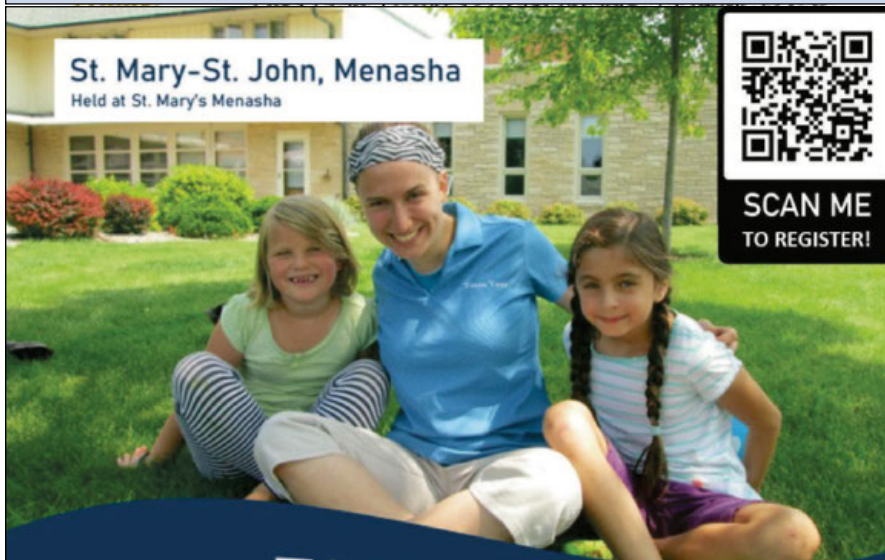
**St. John the Baptist** trustee elections will be held on the weekend of June 25 & 26.

Please prayerfully consider whether you or someone you know may be called to the role of Secretary Trustee. All candidates who are at least 18 years of age and who receive at least ten nominations and are approved by the Pastor between May 14 and June 5 will be included in the final vote, which again will be held the weekend of June 25-26. These candidates' names will be introduced at Masses on June 11 and 12, and short biographies will appear in the bulletin. Nomination forms will be found in the back of both churches, at the parish office, and on our website, along with additional details on trustee roles and responsibilities. Completed forms should be deposited in designated lock boxes in the back of both churches or at the parish office, by no later than June 4. Thank you to Jane Julius who has served our parish as Secretary Trustee for this past term.



**St. Mary** will hold a trustee election on the weekend of June 25 & 26. St. Mary's Treasurer Trustee's term expires in July. Bill Walsh currently serves as Treasurer Trustee and we would like to thank him for his service. Nominations of any parishioner in good standing can be made by placing nomination slips in the ballot boxes at the back of both churches after Mass, or in the office during the week between Saturday,

May 14 and Sunday, June 5. The nomination slips will be found in the church, in the office, or online. Any parishioner who receives ten nominations, is approved by the pastor, and accepts the nomination, will be placed on the ballot. These candidates' names will be introduced at Masses on June 11 and 12, and short biographies will appear in the bulletin. Elections will be held on June 25 & 26 at St. Mary Masses, with all St. Mary parishioners eighteen and older, and in good standing are eligible to cast a paper ballot. A complete description of the trustee position can be found on the parish website.
