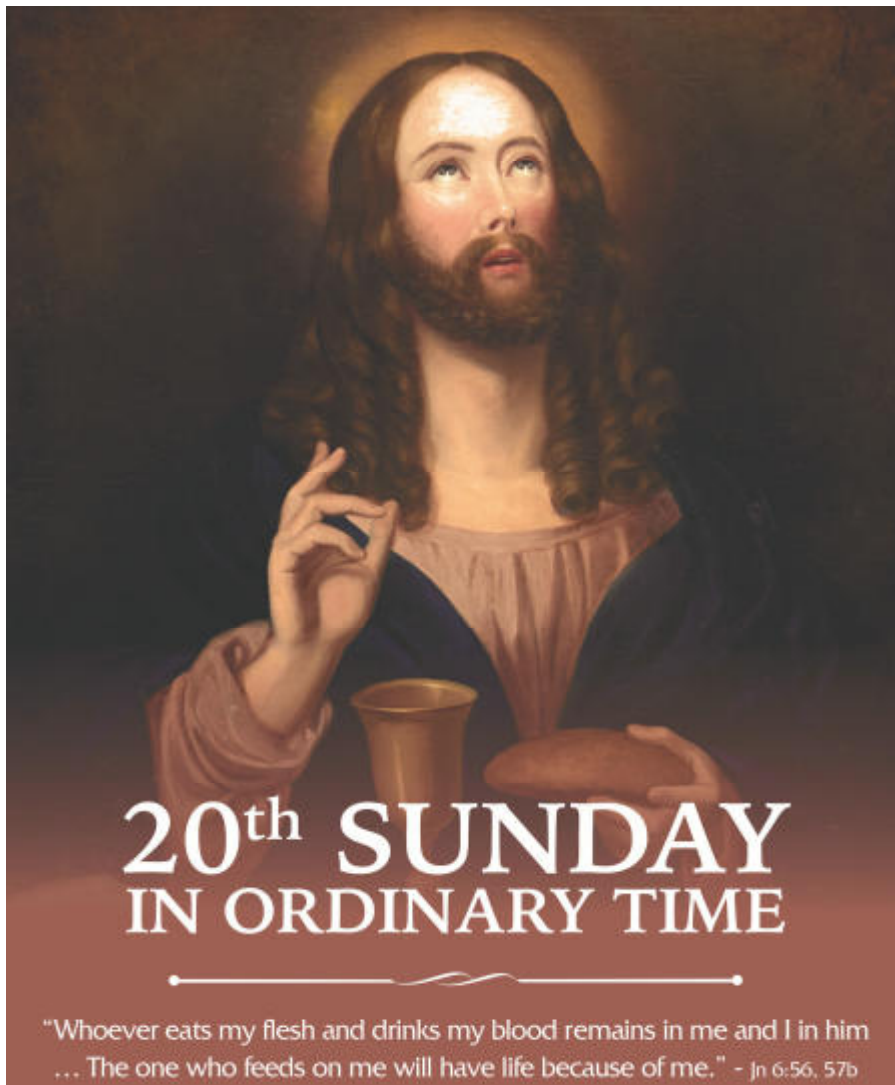

## CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS

### BAPTISM

Family must be active registered members **prior** to asking for baptism, use collection envelopes, participate in parish activities, and attend a class for parents. **Baptisms will usually be celebrated in church on the second Saturday of each month at 10:00am. (this might possibly vary).**

### RECONCILIATION

Saturdays - 9am until all are heard, or by Appointment. Call the parish office for an appointment at a mutual time with our priest.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education is for children who attend public schools in grades K-8. To fully prepare for sacraments, students need to begin classes no later than the beginning of 1<sup>st</sup> grade and remain enrolled through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. ### RCIA

The Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults is a year around ongoing process preparing adults for full membership in the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. Call the Pastor or the Parish Office for more information, **260-432-5113, ext 310.** Now (**anytime**) is the time to begin the process.

### MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 6 months in advance. **Important: Please call the Parish Office before you book the reception hall - or - set a date.**

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Please call the Parish Office to reach a priest and arrange for the anointing when someone is ill or in the hospital. Remember that we pray for recuperation and healing.

Women's group will meet Saturday's at 9am beginning next Saturday, Aug. 25 in the Parish Office.

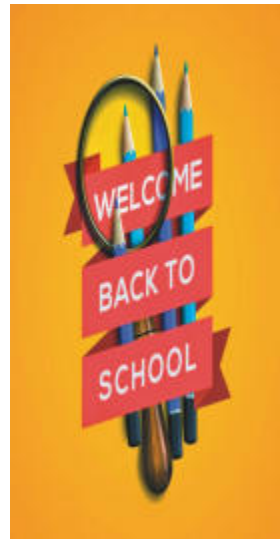

Sr. Yasinta Godfrey is a Sister from Tanzania, East Africa. She is the first born of six children. Sister made her first vows in 2002, final vows 2010. She is a teacher in the secondary school. Sister has also completed her education as an Education Administrator.

Sister Betty Vetter, SDS worked as a nursing instructor for SDS home missions for the Lakota Native Americans in South Dakota, and ministered in India and the Philippines. Despite the long distance between the Lakota tribe and people of Kerala, India, Sister Betty found many cultural similarities, especially religious practices. Her experiences among people living in extreme poverty brought Scriptural passages to life and revealed great generosity in sharing the goodness and kindness of Jesus as Savior.
