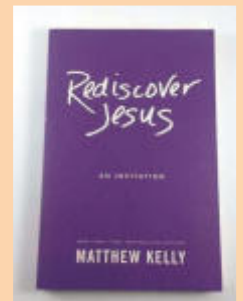

CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM Prior to celebrating a baptism for your child, parents and chosen godparents must attend a class about baptism. Baptism classes will take place on the 1st Sunday of each month. (This might occasionally vary.) **Baptisms in Spanish will usually be celebrated in church on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00am. Please note: Children older than 7 years of age must be interviewed by the RCIA Coordinator.**

RECONCILIATION

Saturdays - 9am until all are heard, or by Appointment. Call the parish office for an appointment for a mutual time with our priest.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education is for children who attend public schools in grades K-8. To fully prepare for sacraments, students need to begin classes no later than the beginning of 1st grade and remain enrolled through 8th grade. Please contact **our Religious Education Director, Ana Ponce, in the Parish Office** for further details, 260-432-5113, ext. 319.

RCIA

The Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults is a year around ongoing process preparing adults for full membership in the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. Call the Pastor or the Parish Office for more information, **260-432-5113, ext 323**. Now (**anytime**) is the time to begin the process.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 6 months in advance. **Important: Please call the Parish Office before you book the reception hall - or - set a date.**

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Please call the Parish Office to reach a priest and arrange for the anointing when someone is ill or in the hospital. Remember that we pray for recuperation and healing.
