

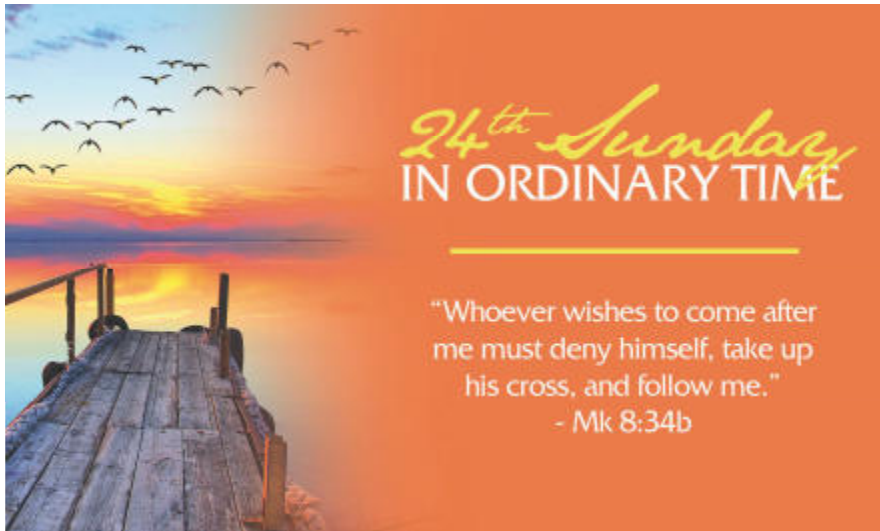

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

The following is a direct quote from St. Pope John Paul II, encouraging us to spend time with Christ in front of the Blessed Sacrament:

"The visit to the Blessed Sacrament is a great treasure of the Catholic faith. It nourishes social love and gives us opportunities for adoration and thanksgiving, for reparation and supplication. Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Holy Hours and Eucharistic processions are likewise precious element of your heritage—in full accord with the teaching of the Second Vatican Council. It is also my joy to reaffirm before the whole world the wonderful teaching of the Catholic Church regarding Christ's consoling presence in the Blessed Sacrament: his Real Presence in the fullest sense: the substantial presence by which the whole and complete Christ, God and man, are present.

The Eucharist, in the Mass and outside of the Mass, is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, and is therefore deserving of the worship that is given to the living God, and to him alone. And so, dear brothers and sisters, every act of reverence, every genuflection that you make before the Blessed Sacrament, is important because it is an act of faith in Christ, an act of love for Christ. And every sign of the Cross and gesture of respect made each time you pass a church is also an act of faith.

May God preserve you in this faith--this holy Catholic faith--this faith in the Blessed Sacrament."

Each Monday, at 8am in English and 6:30pm in Spanish, Deacon José presents the Eucharistic Adoration, Liturgy of the Word, Communion and Benediction in the St Joseph Chapel, off the North Vestibule.

Parishioners can also attend Eucharistic Adoration each Sunday from the hours of 10am through 2pm. Parishioners are encouraged to come, stay as much or as little time as you wish.

CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM Prior to celebrating a baptism for your child, parents and chosen godparents must attend a class about baptism. Baptism classes will take place on the 1st Sunday of each month. (This might occasionally vary.) **Baptisms in Spanish will usually be celebrated in church on the 2nd Saturday of each month at 10:00am. Please note: Children older than 7 years of age must be interviewed by the RCIA Coordinator.**

RECONCILIATION

Saturdays - 9am until all are heard, or by Appointment. Call the parish office for an appointment for a mutual time with our priest.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education is for children who attend public schools in grades K-8. To fully prepare for sacraments, students need to begin classes no later than the beginning of 1st grade and remain enrolled through 8th grade. RCIA

The Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults is a year around ongoing process preparing adults for full membership in the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. Call the Pastor or the Parish Office for more information, **260-432-5113, ext 323**. Now (**anytime**) is the time to begin the process.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 6 months in advance. **Important: Please call the Parish Office before you book the reception hall - or - set a date.**

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Please call the Parish Office to reach a priest and arrange for the anointing when someone is ill or in the hospital. Remember that we pray for recuperation and healing.

Classes are required of girls wishing to celebrate a quinceañera. Please call the Parish Office 6 months in advance of date and/or call Lorenza at 260.515.5162 to schedule the quinceañera and to sign up for classes.
