


Indiana Catholic Bishops Extend Mass Dispensation

While commending our pastors and pastoral life coordinators who have gone to great lengths to assure safe worship spaces in our churches, given the continued increase of Covid-19 cases in our state, the Indiana bishops hereby extend the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation beyond **1 November 2020 until further notice.** The Indiana bishops will continue to monitor the situation to determine when it might be advisable to modify or lift the dispensation.

Parish members of ANY age can attend Weekday Masses, 8am in English, Tues-Sat, and 6:30pm in Spanish, Tues-Sat. There is ample room for those who are interested! Please know you are welcome and PLEASE WEAR MASKS!

CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM If you would like to schedule a baptism, please come by the parish office to receive a list of available dates and a list of requirements. Baptism registration form needs to be filled out at the parish office before taking the pre-baptismal class.

RECONCILIATION Saturdays - 9am until all are heard, or by appointment. Call the parish office for an appointment for a mutual time with our priest.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION Religious Education is for children who attend public schools in grades 1-8. To fully prepare for sacraments, students need to begin classes no later than the beginning of 1st grade and remain enrolled through 8th grade. Please contact our **Religious Education Director, Ana Ponce, in the Parish Office** for further details, **260-432-5113, ext. 319.**

RCIA The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a year-round ongoing process preparing adults for full membership in the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. Call the "Pastor or the Parish Office for more information, **260-432-5113, ext. 323.** Now (**anytime**) is the time to begin the process.

MARRIAGE Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least 6 months in advance. **Important: Please call the Parish Office before you book the reception hall or set a date.**

ANOINTING OF THE SICK Call the Parish Office to reach a priest and arrange for the anointing when someone is ill or in the hospital. Remember that we pray for recuperation and healing.

TRES AÑOS: 3 year old presentations are held during Sunday Spanish Masses. Please call the parish office ahead of time if you would like to schedule a presentation for your baptized child.
