

7TH SUNDAY OF EASTER



"I do not ask that you take them out of the world but that you keep them from the evil one. They do not belong to the world any more than I belong to the world. Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth." - Jn 17:15-17

Some years ago I was blessed to be part of a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. My parents came too.

Each place tells a story and now I read the Gospels in a different way: I've seen many of the places mentioned and some of them now have human connections that involve my parents.

I remember the Via Dolorosa in Jerusalem not so much for the market atmosphere but for my Mother being captivated by the view of the Lion's Gate.



I also remember the Church of the Ascension at the Mount of Olives for my Dad. As the guide explained the history and the tradition, so I saw my Dad place his hands instinctively on the spot on the floor where Jesus is said to have risen to His Father. It moved me. My Dad's act of faith inspired me. It helped me see that everything I was taught to believe, is true.

Ever since then, I have approached today's feast with a new perspective. I used to just see it as Jesus completing His mission and going Home.

Now I see the Ascension of Jesus as that last revelation of His greatness on earth. He wanted to share His greatness with us and I witnessed my Dad trying to feel that greatness in very prayerful way at the Mount of Olives.

Jesus shares everything with us, even His greatness. He wants us with Him now as much as He wants us with Him in heaven.

Cuando el guía iba explicando la historia y la tradición, vi que mi Papa puso sus manos instintivamente en el lugar en el piso donde Jesús donde se dice que Jesús resucitó a Su Padre. Eso me conmovió. Ese acto de fé de mi Papa me inspiro, me ayudo a ver que todo lo que me enseñaron, es verdad.

Desde entonces, he visto la festividad del día de hoy con una nueva perspectiva.

Antes lo veía como Jesús completando su misión y partiendo a Casa.

Ahora veo a la Ascension de Jesús como esa última revelación de Su grandeza en la tierra. Él quería compartir Su grandeza con nosotros y yo fui testigo de ese momento en que mi papá trato de sentir esa grandeza en oración en el Monte de los Olivos.


Jesús comparte todo con nosotros, aun Su grandeza. Él nos quiere con nosotros tanto como Él nos quiere con Él en el cielo.









The Prayer Shawl Ministry provides a way to literally wrap people in prayer. Prayer shawls are knitted or crocheted by members of our parish and then given to those who are in need of our prayers. "We remember all those for whom we complete these shawls or lapghans: those who are lonely and need to know they are loved; those who are ill and yearn for healing of body, mind and spirit; those who face challenging decisions and search for guidance; those who are grieving and welcome comforting words and actions; those who are celebrating newness of life and rejoice in the warmth and richness surrounding them. 

Laudato Si'



Pope Francis invites Catholic communities around the world to celebrate Laudato Si' Week from May 16 to May 24, 2021.

The sixth anniversary of Laudato Si' coincides with important events in the race to find solutions to the environmental crisis.

“LAUDATO SI’, mi’ Signore” – “Praise be to you, my Lord.” These are the words that open Pope Francis’ encyclical on ecology and care for God’s creation. These words, quoting St. Francis of Assisi’s beautiful canticle, remind us that our common home is like a sister with whom we share our life and a beautiful mother who opens her arms to embrace us.

Pope Francis’ encyclical letter *Laudato Si’* was released in June 2015. Five years later, in 2020, Pope Francis invited all Catholics and people of good will to celebrate its fifth anniversary by protecting families and future generations through action to care for our common home.




