**Reflection** We can all likely recall times when we were attempting to do something and we were told that we had only one chance to complete the task. Sometimes we were successful in accomplishing what we set out to do. At other times, for any number of reasons, we “missed the mark”. Maybe we were sick, tired, late, short on time, didn’t have needed information, or any number of other reasons. We were grateful if given another chance to succeed.

This weekend’s first reading describes Peter talking to the people, pointing out the many ways God had blessed them, yet they were unfaithful. He reminds them that they “denied the Holy and Righteous One, put him to death, but God raised him from the dead”. He went on to say, “I know, that you acted out of ignorance, Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away.”

Keep in mind that Peter is a perfect example of “missing the mark”, yet he put aside his pride, repented, and tried again. He often took risks and spoke up when Jesus posed questions or challenges, but he didn’t stop taking risks. He even denied Jesus three times before he was crucified. While he made mistakes, Peter never gave up and stayed the course.

Peter might be described as the master of “second chances”. The gospel is yet another example of second chances, where Jesus returns a second time to give the disciples assurance that he was with them. Recall that last week we heard Jesus wish them peace, and he extended forgiveness. This week he again offers his peace. In the Easter season we will continue to hear accounts of Jesus connecting with the apostles, to strengthen them.

The readings this weekend give us renewed confidence and consolation that we all fail but more importantly we are continually invited to repent and return to be faithful.

You may have heard the song, “Our God is an awesome God” and it is truly awesome that God is always ready to forgive, welcome us back, and extend us peace! *Fr. Tom*



## PASTOR'S UPDATE

**Dear all,** my Pastor update this week brings news, surprise, and change-all factors of life!

As a bit of background for recent members, until July 2014, there was a one Priest/Pastor for Cathedral/St. Pat's. With my arrival we moved to having a Pastor and Associate Pastor. Since many only see us on weekends, it was first viewed as a pleasant surprise and increased opportunity. What people did not realize was that while Pastor, I am considered  $\frac{1}{4}$  Pastor and  $\frac{3}{4}$  Vicar General of the Archdiocese; Fr. Alan was  $\frac{3}{4}$  Associate and  $\frac{1}{4}$  Wahlert, thus still a full-time equivalency for the parishes.

Assignments are driven by the availability of priests. When Fr. Alan was re-assigned, Fr. Greg came and he was  $\frac{1}{2}$  time with the parishes and  $\frac{1}{2}$  time as Director of Worship. He has now been called forth to a new ministry which will include the opportunity to use his Doctor of Ministry in a higher academic setting (Mt. Mercy University) while continuing to serve the Archdiocese.

The official announcement read: “Pastoral care of Sacred Heart parish in Oxford Junction will once again be the responsibility of the Archdiocese of Dubuque, and Father Greg Bahl will be re-assigned as Pastor, as well as Chaplain of Mt. Mercy University in Cedar Rapids while continuing his ministry as Director of the Archdiocesan Office of Worship, after serving as Associate Pastor of the Cathedral of St. Raphael and St. Patrick parishes in Dubuque.

After Deacon Martin Coolidge is ordained a priest, he will be assigned as Associate Pastor of the Cathedral of St. Raphael and St. Patrick parishes in Dubuque, with chaplaincy duties, together with Father Andy Upah, at Holy Family Catholic Schools in Dubuque.”


Deacon Martin spent a summer here during his 1<sup>st</sup> year summer seminarian experience at the Cathedral, working with the homebound and the Hispanic community.

He will be  $\frac{1}{4}$  with Holy Family Catholic Schools and  $\frac{3}{4}$  with our parishes, and in particular responding to the needs of the Hispanic Community.

Please pray for us. We hope to get Fr. Greg back for a “covid-correct” farewell. We will also welcome “soon to be Fr. Martin” in a similar way. Thanks for your understanding
