Our next movie is based on the true story behind the song, Amazing Grace. When you understand the depths behind the words of this beautiful hymn you'll have a greater appreciation for its message.

John Newton's life wasn't easy. As a young man he was extremely troubled, had a violent temper, and a penchant for vulgarity that literally made his fellow sailors blush. Whipped for desertion and sold into slavery, it seemed his life would end early as in a West African grave...until he was rescued by a ship captain sent by his father.

Before a powerful conversion experience during a storm at sea, Newton is appointed captain of a slave ship himself. In an age when human bondage was considered the norm, it would take time for Newton's conscience to be thoroughly transformed. Eventually Newton came to hate the slave trade, becoming a spiritual leader in the fight to end slavery.

This movie is the dramatic true story of a real "Prodigal Son's" miraculous forgiveness and change that lies behind the powerful words of one of the world's most beloved hymns.

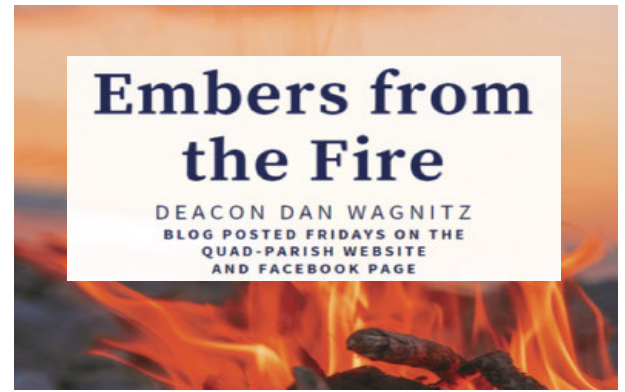

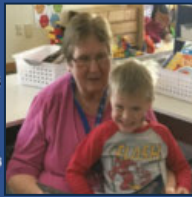

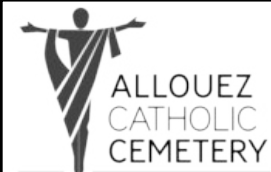
