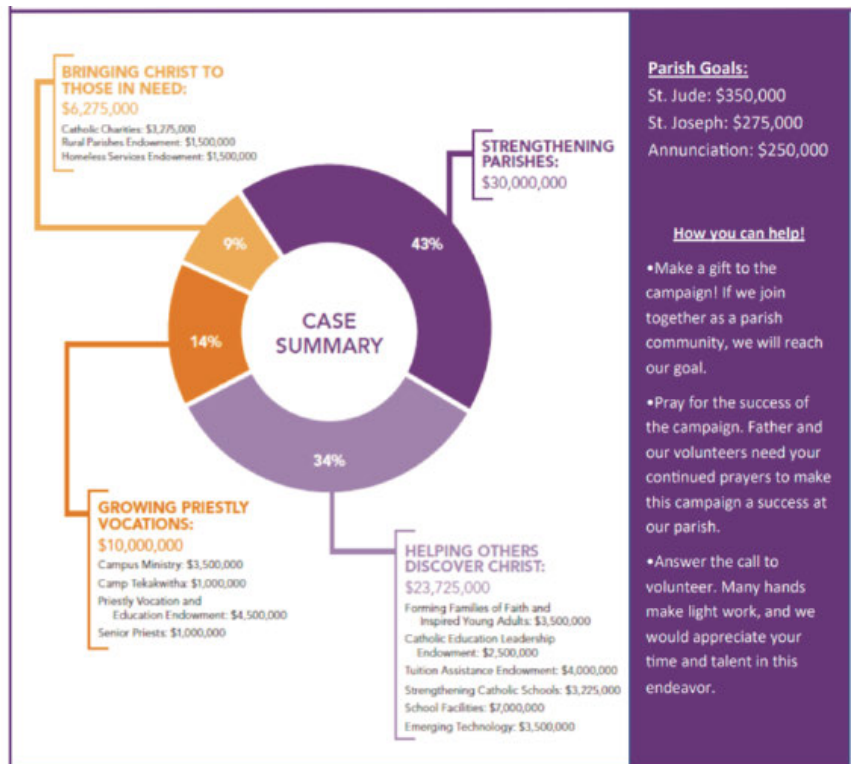

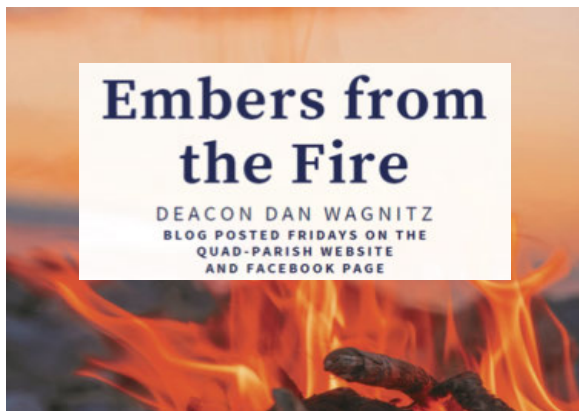
**Our parishes will receive 50% of all funds collected at the parish level.**

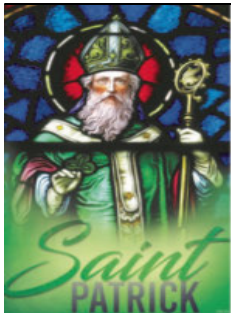

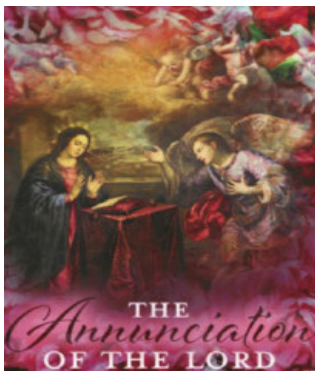
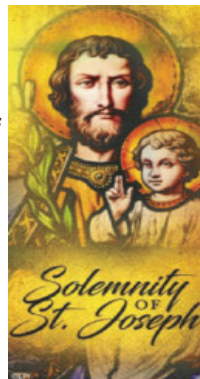
