## The God of Newness

Today's gospel reading is short but so amazing. God only asks <u>one thing</u> of us, to love one another as God has loved us. Compare that command to all the challenges you have heard in your lifetime. Make something of yourself, go to college, get a degree and if you are really wise don't stop at a college degree go on for a Masters, and a PhD.

Or make a name for yourself by making tons of money, or do something that will make you famous, a star or a celebrity. Sure we have to act as mature adults and support ourselves and our families. But do we get so caught up with pushing the envelope further and further out that we lose sight of the things in life that really matter?

The second reading from Revelation should touch our hearts if we are really listening. God is waiting for the end time when earth as we know it will pass so that <u>God will literally dwell among us</u>, heaven and earth will be one, together in one place, and there will be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain. God will even wipe every tear from our eyes.

This place we call earth will be made anew. God promised, *"Behold, I make all things new."* God has never broken a promise made to any human.

#### **Dear Parishioners**,

If you or a family member is ever in the hospital, please know that you can call the parish directly to let us know. Often times we are unaware of parishioners who are in the hospital and a call to the Quad Parish office would help us in knowing this. Changes in regulations protecting patient confidentiality are in effect at all hospitals. Even when the hospital asks if they may notify us of your admission and you answer "yes", it is still helpful if you or a family member notifies us directly, especially if someone needs to receive the **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**. Due to HIPPA regulations the hospitals are not able to notify us of a patient's condition, which is why your help in letting us know directly would be very helpful. You can also call the Pastoral Care Department at any hospital to notify us on your behalf.

Article 1421 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church states: The Lord Jesus Christ, physician of our souls and bodies, who forgave the sins of the paralytic and restored him to bodily health, has willed that his Church continue, in the power of the Holy Spirit, his work of healing and salvation, even among her own members. This is the purpose of the two sacraments of healing: the sacrament of Penance and the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

### "Check It Out" at the QPO Library

Over time a number of people have donated books to the Quad-Parish. There are books on prayer, the Bible, saints, grief, women's ministry, spirituality, church history and even some novels. 

Laundry Love-Green Bay exists to meet the needs of those in our community who are low income, homeless, unemployed, elderly or someone needing a hand up.


