## Important Words

**John 14: 23-29**

**"Those who love me will keep my Word and my Father will love them and we will come to them and make our home with them..."**

These words were part of Jesus' farewell discourse during the Last Supper with His disciples. The next day – Good Friday – He manifested his great outpouring of love nailed on the Cross – a love which remained the same, yesterday, today & forever.

But Jesus asks us to rely on His sufficient grace moving forward so that in due time, we shall rejoice in the company of the Father. **Believing in Jesus** gives us the confidence that **we're temples of the Holy Spirit**. And His Spirit will ever guide and enlighten us to understand deeply His Word and keep it in our hearts.

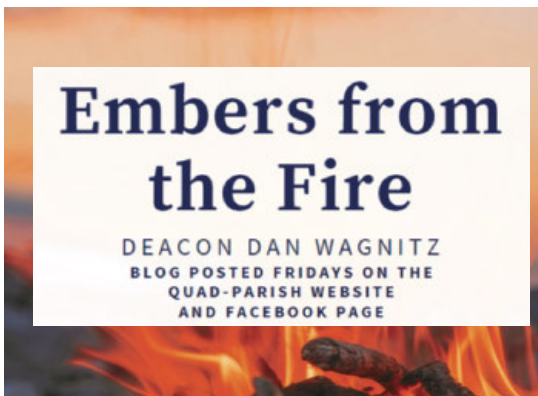
